





THE JUBILEE 2025 CORNER

Welcome to Jubilee Corner for all information on the Jubilee Year of Hope and upcoming events for Sacred Heart Parish.

JUBILEE HISTORY

The origins of Christian Jubilee date back to ancient Israel when the Law of Moses prescribed a special year for the Jewish people in the fiftieth year as told in *Leviticus 25:10-14*. In the New Testament, Jesus presents himself as the One who brings the Old Jubilee to completion, because he has come "to preach the year of the Lord's favor" Lk 4:16-21. The Jubilee is called Holy Year because its purpose is to encourage holiness in life, strengthen faith, encourage work of charity and brotherly communion within the church and to be more sincere and coherent in their faith in Christ, the only Savior. Jubilees can be "ordinary" or "extraordinary". A Jubilee is ordinary when it falls within a set period of time and extraordinary when it is proclaimed for some outstanding event. The first Jubilee was proclaimed in 1300 by Pope Boniface VII and due to the many requests for a second Jubilee, Clement VI set a period of 50 years between Jubilees. In 1470, Pope Paul II fixed the Jubilees for every 25 years and the next Jubilee was in 1475 beginning the 25 year tradition.

PLENARY INDULGENCES

A plenary indulgence is a grace granted by the Catholic Church through the merits of Jesus Christ to remove the temporal punishment due to sin. Such an indulgence, which applies to sins already forgiven, cleanses the soul as if the person has just been baptized. A plenary indulgence can be gained only once a day, although during a Jubilee year according to the Apostolic Penitentiary, a second plenary indulgence can be gained if it is applied to souls in purgatory. In order to obtain it, the faithful must, in addition to being in a state of grace:

- have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, even venial sin;
- have sacramentally confessed their sins;
- receive the Holy Eucharist (it is better to receive it while participating in Holy Mass, but for the indulgence only Holy Communion is required);
- pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff.

It is appropriate, but not necessary, that the sacramental Confession and especially Holy Communion and the prayer for the Pope's intentions take place on the same day that the indulgenced work is performed; but it is sufficient that these sacred rites and prayers be carried out with several days (about 20) before or after the indulgenced act. Prayer for the Pope's intentions is left to the choice of the faithful, but an "Our Father" and a "Hail Mary" are suggested. One sacramental Confession suffices for several plenary indulgences, but a separate Holy communion and a separate prayer for the Holy Father's intentions are required for each plenary indulgence.






