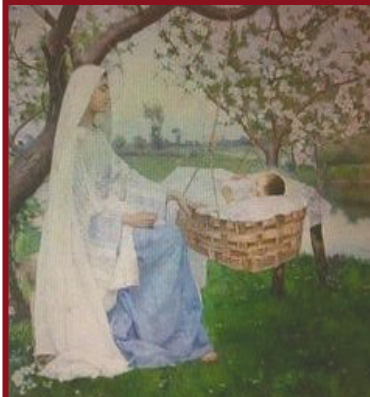

Ayman Khair is representing Christian families from the
Holy Land. These families have been dependent upon sales
of their hand carved religious articles to tourists of the Holy
Land. Due to the conflict in the Middle East and the War
tourism has been stopped completely.

It is very important to support them at this critical time since
they have no income and there is no tourism at all. In order to
survive, they have turned to Christian communities in the
United States to purchase their articles.

These **hand carved religious articles are beyond
description.** Carved from **wood of the sacred Olive tree**,
this workmanship has been traditional for these families for
hundreds of years. It is hoped that through the efforts of Mr.
Khair, these families who have little income will be able to
stay living and survive in the Holy Land.

Sadly enough, the Christian population dropped from 22 % to
less than 2% in the last 20 years. Thank you in advance for
your support.

With a little encouragement from our Care for the Earth Ministry, and a generous donation from the Knights of Columbus, the students started their very own composting program for their lunch food waste! The Food Service adds the fruits and veggies left over at the end of the week, and the Knights even added used coffee grounds from their last parish breakfast. The students are learning how it benefits the environment - keeping all that waste out of the landfill and returning essential nutrients back to the soil. In fact, the compost that they produce will be used in their school garden! It’s all a part of caring for the Earth.

This new program just adds to the many ways the school has been promoting care for the earth for many years. They have a collection bin for plastic bags that are taken for recycling. And they encourage the use of reusable water bottles. In fact, they have a drinking fountain equipped with a bottle refilling station. Very cool for the environment!

Please take a look at our new display at the front of the church that explains more about their impressive achievement. And if you’re at the school one day, stop by to see their raised bed gardens, and new composting bins. You’ll be inspired!

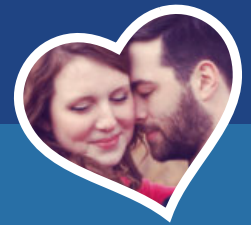

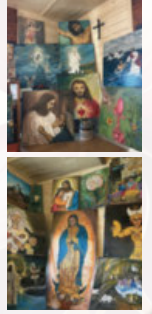
