Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Our whole life, when authentically Christian, is oriented toward love. Only love makes our existence fruitful and brings forth eternal salvation.

And we know that this Christian love has two dimensions. The horizontal dimension: loving humanity, our brothers and sisters. And the vertical dimension: to love God, our Lord.

It is easy to speak of love and charity, but it is difficult to live them, because to love means to serve, and to serve requires giving oneself.

For this reason, the Lord gave us the ideal image in the Blessed Virgin Mary. She is the great servant of God and, at the same time, of humanity.

At the hour of the Annunciation, she proclaims herself the handmaid of the Lord. She gives God her whole body, to fulfill the task that God entrusts to her by the angel. She changes on the spot all her plans and projects for her life, that she may have dreamed to do, she completely forgets about her own interests to place God and humanity first. The same thing happens to her, in today's Gospel, with Elizabeth. She learns that her cousin is going to have a child and she leaves right away to serve another, despite the long road. And she stayed with her for three months, serving her until the birth of John the Baptist. It doesn't occur to her to feel superior. And she doesn't look for excuses for being pregnant and not being able to risk such a long journey.

She does all this, because she knows that in the Kingdom of God the first are those who know how to become servants of all.

Our own Christian life must also be formed and developed in these same two dimensions: commitment to our brothers and sisters and service to God. For this reason one of the early Church Fathers says that the life of the committed Christian is represented on the cross: The horizontal wood symbolizes love and service to others; the vertical wood symbolizes love and service to God.

And you can't separate one dimension from the other. Therefore, the more we want to communicate with humanity, the more we must be in communion with God. And the more we want to draw closer to God, the more we must be closer to humanity.

What else can today's Gospel tell us? It tells us of some miraculous events in the meeting of the two women: the child jumps for joy in the womb of his mother; Elizabeth is filled with the Holy Spirit, recognizes the Lord's presence, and begins to prophesy.

And we might ask ourselves: Is it the Blessed Virgin Mary who performs these miracles? This can be explained only by the intimate and profound union between Mary and Jesus. That union begins with the Annunciation and lasts her entire life and beyond. And for the first time it manifests itself in Mary's encounter with Elizabeth.

Mary never acts alone, but always in this perfect union between Mother and Son. Where Mary is, there is also Jesus. It is the mystery of the infinite fruitfulness of her life as a mother.

And if we want to be like Her, then it must also be the mystery of our life. In what sense? We unite, we bond with Mary, our Mother and Queen. And then what does she do? She binds us, with all the roots of our being, with her beloved Son Jesus Christ.

Because Mary is the land of encounter with Christ, she leads us to Him, guides us, cares for us and accompanies us in our journey towards Him.

It seems to me that today's Gospel reveals yet another message: Mary not only leads us to Christ, but brings, above all, Jesus to the world and to humanity. It is her great task as Mother of God.

And on her visit to Elizabeth's house she performs, for the first time, this great mission of hers: she takes her Son into the world to be shared with others. And the Lord of the world, incarnated in her maternal body, manifests his presence through those miracles.

Mary did it more than 2000 years ago. But she does so also today: She brings Christ to us.

With this Sunday we are already very close to Christmas. On Christmas Eve we will celebrate the coming of Jesus in our midst. On Christmas Eve, Mary wants to give us the greatest gift that a human being can make: God himself, made man in the baby Jesus. Through His Mother and our Mother, Christ wants to be born again in our hearts, He wants to fill them with His love, His joy, His peace.

Dear brothers and sisters, let us therefore ask Mary to prepare us for Christmas, to open our closed hearts, to awaken in us the same attitude of longing and waiting for the Redeemer that she had.

Then, Jesus at Christmas is going to be born again in our hearts and take possession of them. So, the days of Christmas are going to be a time of deep grace, joy and fruitfulness for us and humanity.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Toda nuestra vida, cuando es auténticamente cristiana, está orientada al amor. Sólo el amor hace que nuestra existencia sea fructífera y que se produzca la salvación eterna.

Y sabemos que este amor cristiano tiene dos dimensiones. La dimensión horizontal: amar a la humanidad, a nuestros hermanos. Y la dimensión vertical: amar a Dios, nuestro Señor.

Es fácil hablar del amor y de la caridad, pero es difícil vivirlos, porque amar significa servir, y servir requiere entregarse.

Por eso, el Señor nos dio la imagen ideal de la Virgen María. Ella es la gran servidora de Dios y, al mismo tiempo, de la humanidad.

En la hora de la Anunciación, se proclama esclava del Señor. Entrega a Dios todo su cuerpo, para cumplir la tarea que Dios le confía por el ángel. Cambia en el acto todos los planes y proyectos de su vida, que había soñado hacer, se olvida por completo de sus propios intereses para poner a Dios y a la humanidad en primer lugar.

Lo mismo le ocurre, en el Evangelio de hoy, con Isabel. Se entera de que su prima va a tener un hijo y se va enseguida a servirle, a pesar del largo camino. Y se queda con ella durante tres meses, sirviendo hasta el nacimiento de Juan el Bautista. No se le ocurre sentirse superior. Y no busca excusas por estar embarazada y no poder arriesgarse a un viaje tan largo.

Hace todo esto, porque sabe que en el Reino de Dios los primeros son los que saben hacerse servidores de todos.

Nuestra propia vida cristiana también debe formarse y desarrollarse en estas dos mismas dimensiones: el compromiso con los hermanos y el servicio a Dios. Por eso, uno de los primeros Padres de la Iglesia dice que la vida del cristiano comprometido está representada en la cruz: El madero horizontal simboliza el amor y el servicio a los demás; el madero vertical simboliza el amor y el servicio a Dios.

Y no se puede separar una dimensión de la otra. Por eso, cuanto más queremos comunicarnos con la humanidad, más debemos estar en comunión con Dios. Y cuanto más queramos acercarnos a Dios, más debemos acercarnos a la humanidad.

¿Qué más puede decirnos el Evangelio de hoy? Nos habla de algunos acontecimientos milagrosos en el encuentro de las dos mujeres: el niño salta de alegría en el seno de su madre; Isabel se llena del Espíritu Santo, reconoce la presencia del Señor y comienza a profetizar.

Y podemos preguntarnos: ¿Es la Santísima Virgen María quien realiza estos milagros? Esto sólo puede explicarse por la íntima y profunda unión entre María y Jesús. Esa unión comienza con la Anunciación y dura toda su vida y más allá. Y se manifiesta por primera vez en el encuentro de María con Isabel.

María nunca actúa sola, sino siempre en esta unión perfecta entre Madre e Hijo. Donde está María, está también Jesús. Es el misterio de la infinita fecundidad de su vida de madre.

Y si queremos ser como Ella, también debe ser el misterio de nuestra vida. ¿En qué sentido? Nos unimos, nos vinculamos a María, nuestra Madre y Reina. ¿Y qué hace Ella? Ella nos une, con todas las raíces de nuestro ser, con su amado Hijo Jesucristo.

Porque María es la tierra del encuentro con Cristo, nos lleva a Él, nos guía, nos cuida y nos acompaña en nuestro camino hacia Él.

Me parece que el Evangelio de hoy revela otro mensaje: María no sólo nos lleva a Cristo, sino que lleva, sobre todo, a Jesús al mundo y a la humanidad. Es su gran tarea como Madre de Dios.

Y en su visita a la casa de Isabel realiza, por primera vez, esta gran misión suya: lleva a su Hijo al mundo para compartirlo con los demás. Y el Señor del mundo, encarnado en su cuerpo materno, manifiesta su presencia a través de esos milagros. María lo hizo hace más de 2000 años. Pero también lo hace hoy: Ella nos trae a Cristo.

Con este domingo estamos ya muy cerca de la Navidad. En Nochebuena celebraremos la venida de Jesús en medio de nosotros. En Nochebuena, María quiere hacernos el mayor regalo que puede hacer un ser humano: Dios mismo, hecho

hombre en el niño Jesús. A través de su Madre y de nuestra Madre, Cristo quiere nacer de nuevo en nuestros corazones, quiere llenarlos de su amor, de su alegría, de su paz.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas, pidamos pues a María que nos prepare para la Navidad, que abra nuestros corazones cerrados, que despierte en nosotros la misma actitud de anhelo y de espera del Salvador que ella tuvo.

Entonces, Jesús en Navidad va a nacer de nuevo en nuestros corazones y va a tomar posesión de ellos. Así, los días de Navidad van a ser un tiempo de profunda gracia, alegría y fecundidad para nosotros y la humanidad.
