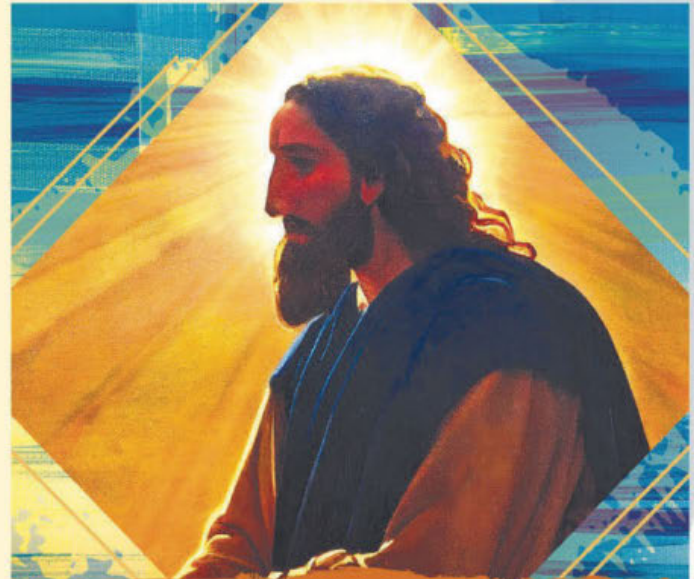

FROM THE PASTOR

JUNE 25, 2023

This section of the Gospel according to Matthew always encourages and strengthens me. Jesus is so clear to His apostles (and now to all of us disciples): **"Fear no one...what you hear whispered, proclaim on the housetops... Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul..."** Matthew 10:26-28

It reminds us of what our wonderful and holy father Saint John Paul II said at his installation Mass - and would repeat for the rest of his life: **Be Not Afraid!** It became a sort of motto for him. He proclaimed it to the young people at World Youth Days, to Latin Americans and Europeans suffering under communism, to the Church in Africa enduring famines and persecution. He spoke it to couples and families going through terrible stress and the sick in their illnesses. Of course, John Paul II was just repeating what Jesus told His disciples time and again: **Be not afraid!**

It wouldn't take too long to make a list of the many problems our families, friends, communities, country and world are facing right now. We have brothers and sisters in Christ around the world facing persecution and martyrdom and are actually having to take these words of Jesus seriously. Since May 3 over 100 Christians have been killed and 253 churches burned in the Manipur region of India. Over 52,250 Christians have been killed in Nigeria for their faith in Jesus Christ - just since 2014. In Chile, in October 2020, I witnessed with gut-wrenching sadness the burning down of the Church of the Assumption Parish in Santiago by the enemies of Christ's Body.



Closer to home we know Christ suffers on the streets everyday, immigrants often live in fear, and so many little children have suffered abuse. I don't need to say that some of this has even been carried out by fellow Christians and leaders of the Church. Even many families in our parish are going through really heavy days right now due to divorce, unemployment, addictions or chronic pain.

All this is cause for great despair and fear, right? Sadness and tears, yes. Boldness in our charity, yes. Striving for justice, definitely! But despair and fear... absolutely not! We take Jesus at His word and very seriously - *"fear no one! Proclaim what you hear from Me on the rooftops!"* Jesus has won the victory over sin and death and we are surrounded by the great cloud of witnesses (Hebrews 12:1) on earth and in heaven.

Remember, we Christians aren't "Pollyannas." We suffer - and acknowledge it. But we know how the story ends and Who wins... Jesus lives with us and remains with us every step of the way. Let's really be people who have hope and proclaim it! Be not afraid!

DE PARTE DEL PÁRROCO

25 DE JUNIO, 2023

Esta sección del Evangelio según San Mateo siempre me anima y me fortalece. Jesús es tan claro con Sus apóstoles (y ahora con todos nosotros, discípulos): **"No teman a los hombres... lo que les digo al oído, pregónenlo desde las azoteas... No tengan miedo a los que matan el cuerpo, pero no pueden matar el alma..."** Mat 10:26-28

Nos recuerda lo que nuestro maravilloso y santo padre San Juan Pablo II dijo en su misa de instalación - y repetiría durante el resto de su vida: **¡No tengan miedo!** Se convirtió en una especie de lema para él. Lo proclamó a los jóvenes en las Jornadas Mundiales de la Juventud, a los latinoamericanos y europeos que sufrían bajo el comunismo, a la Iglesia en África que soportaba el hambre y la persecución. Se lo dijo a las parejas y familias que pasaban por terribles tensiones y a los enfermos en sus dolencias. Por supuesto, Juan Pablo II no hacía más que repetir lo que Jesús dijo a sus discípulos una y otra vez: **¡No tengan miedo!**

No llevaría demasiado tiempo hacer una lista de los muchos problemas a los que se enfrentan ahora mismo nuestras familias, amigos, comunidades, país y mundo. Tenemos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo en todo el mundo que se enfrentan a la persecución y al martirio y que realmente están teniendo que tomarse en serio estas palabras de Jesús. Desde el 3 de mayo más de 100 cristianos han sido asesinados y 253 iglesias quemadas en la región de Manipur, India. Más de 52.250 cristianos han sido asesinados en Nigeria por su fe en Jesucristo, solo desde 2014. En Chile, en octubre de 2020, presencié con una tristeza desgarradora el incendio de la Iglesia de la Parroquia de la Asunción en Santiago por los enemigos del Cuerpo de Cristo.



Más cerca de casa sabemos que Cristo sufre en las calles todos los días, los inmigrantes a menudo viven con miedo, y tantos niños pequeños han sufrido abusos. No necesito decir que algunos de estos abusos han sido cometidos por cristianos y líderes de la Iglesia. Incluso muchas familias de nuestra parroquia están atravesando días realmente duros en estos momentos debido al divorcio, el desempleo, las adicciones o el dolor crónico.

Todo esto es motivo de gran desesperación y miedo, ¿Verdad? Tristeza y lágrimas, sí. Ánimo en nuestra caridad, sí. Lucha por la justicia, ¡definitivamente! Pero desesperación y miedo... ¡no! Tomamos a Jesús al pie de la letra y muy en serio: **"¡No temas a nadie! Proclamad a los cuatro vientos lo que escuchéis de Mí". Jesús ha ganado la victoria sobre el pecado y la muerte y estamos rodeados por la gran nube de testigos (Hebreos 12:1) en la tierra y en el cielo.**

Recuerda, los cristianos no siempre somos optimistas y alegres. Sufrimos - y lo reconocemos. Pero sabemos cómo termina la historia y quién gana... Jesús vive con nosotros y permanece con nosotros en cada paso del camino. ¡Seamos realmente personas que tienen esperanza y la proclaman! ¡No tengan miedo!

¡Los quiero mucho a todos y gracias por sus oraciones! Que Dios los bendiga esta semana,

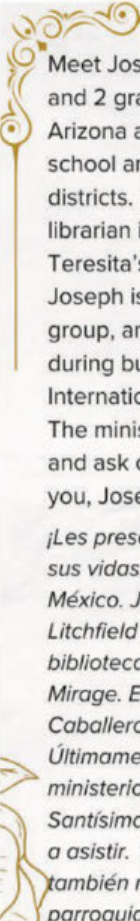

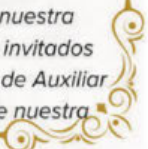
SJV Featured Parishioner for June 2023
