## ON THE FEAST OF THE HOLY FAMILY: OUR OWN FAMILY CIRCLE

Could failure to follow God's commands be robbing your family of grace?

God not only became one of us, but he was born into a family with parents: Our Blessed Mother Mary, and a father, St. Joseph. There's no escaping the message that families are intended to be holy places for children to grow and prepare to enter the world.

The Fourth Commandment orders us to: "Honor your mother and father that your days may be long in the land which the Lord your God gives you." (Exodus 20:12). It's actually the only commandment with a promise attached to it.

Oh, how the value of that commandment has become obvious to us now that we are parents. Too bad we did not esteem it when we were children ourselves. I sometimes wonder if some of the challenges I've faced as a parent are connected to my mother's words coming true: "I hope that one day you have a child just like you."

At the time I thought, "Cool, I wouldn't mind." But with the experience of motherhood, I sometimes wonder if it's payback time now. If the adage, "What goes around, comes around," has any validity, then I certainly never deserved compliant, docile children. There are no do-overs on childhood, so repentance and prayers and some make-up behavior if our parents are still alive, is the best we can do now.

After being retrieved in the temple by Mary and Joseph, "He was obedient to them" (Luke 2:51). Yes, God was obedient to two humans, creatures that he created and was infinitely more powerful than. But these were his parents, so he obeyed them as an example to us.

The Fourth Commandment puts order into a family but it also puts an incredible responsibility on our shoulders as parents. The reason our children are suppose to be obedient to us is because we are taking the place of God here on earth. Those are big shoes to fill. We are not God, but we need to be as close as we can when it comes to our behaviors as a parent because we are suppose to be a reflection of Our Loving Father in the lives of our children.

According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, the Fourth Commandment:

"...shows us the order of charity. God has willed that, after him, we should honor our parents to whom we owe life and who have handed on to us the knowledge of God. We are obliged to honor and respect all those whom God, for our good, has vested with his authority." (2197)

Not only is it our duty to parent in union with God but to respect all those whom God has vested with his authority. As adults, we must still respect our parents, although we are no longer in a position where we must be obedient to them. Also, the fact is that all parents are not religious or providing good examples. Now that we are the parent, it is up to us to be the example to our own children and in some cases to our parents. There may even be resistance. Although most usually imagine it's the grandparents urging the parents and grandchildren towards church, it does also happen that adult children, not raised with religion, are resisted and even persecuted for following their religious values. Still, we must respect our parents, even if it means disagreeing with them. By praying for them and responding always out of love, we show them respect even when there is dissension.

That still does not leave us off the hook when it comes obedience. To honor and respect those vested with God's authority means that we must obey the authority of God in our lives. Just as our children are not honoring us when they disobey us, so too, we are not honoring God when we disobey him. Remember, Jesus told us that he would not leave us orphans. He left us his Church to guide us. God's fatherly and motherly care comes to us through the guidance of his Church and all its teachings.

If this line of reasoning is leading you down a path you had not expected or wanted to go, it might be that you are finding a place to start the spiritual healing in your family. You cannot stand in authority over your children and demand obedience from them and then turn around and refuse obedience to our Heavenly Father.

The commandment to honor and respect is put in positive terms. We are not being told not to do something. Instead, we are given a duty to fulfill. The subsequent commandments follow [and concern] life, marriage, speech and earthly goods. The order of the commandments goes from relating directly to God in the first three—to hold God above all things, not to take his name in vain, and keep his day holy. Then, the next step is to the authority of parents before proceeding to commandments that follow the rest of our daily encounters.

The Catechism says that,

“The Fourth Commandment is addressed expressly to children in their relationship to their father and mother, because this relationship is the most universal. It likewise concerns the ties of kinship between members of the extended family. It requires honor, affection, and gratitude toward elders and ancestors. Finally, it extends to the duties of pupils to teachers, employees to employers, subordinates to leaders, citizens to their country and to those who administer and govern it.

“This commandment includes and presupposes the duties of parents, instructors, teachers, leaders, magistrates, those who govern, all who exercise authority over others or over a community of persons.” (paragraph 2199)

So, becoming an adult does not let us off the hook, even after our parents are deceased. In a way, it can make us feel like we are still children, always needing to obey. But that is a good thing. “Truly I say to you, unless you are converted and become like children, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven” (Matthew 18:3).

# SAGRADA FAMILIA DE NAZARET

Fiesta de la Sagrada Familia, Jesús, María y José, desde la que se proponen santísimos ejemplos a las familias cristianas y se invocan los auxilios oportunos. En la festividad de la Sagrada Familia, recordamos y celebramos que Dios quiso nacer dentro de una familia para que tuviera alguien que lo cuidara, lo protegiera, lo ayudara y lo aceptara como era. Al nacer Jesús en una familia, el Hijo de Dios ha santificado la familia humana. Por eso nosotros veneramos a la Sagrada Familia como Familia de Santos.

## ¿Cómo era la Sagrada Familia?

María y José cuidaban a Jesús, se esforzaban y trabajaban para que nada le faltara, tal como lo hacen todos los buenos padres por sus hijos. José era carpintero, Jesús le ayudaba en sus trabajos, ya que después lo reconocen como el "hijo del carpintero". María se dedicaba a cuidar que no faltara nada en la casa de Nazaret. Tal como era la costumbre en aquella época, los hijos ayudaban a sus mamás moliendo el trigo y acarreando agua del pozo y a sus papás en su trabajo. Podemos suponer que en el caso de Jesús no era diferente. Jesús aprendió a trabajar y a ayudar a su familia con generosidad. Él siendo Todopoderoso, obedecía a sus padres humanos, confiaba en ellos, los ayudaba y los quería.

¡Qué enseñanza nos da Jesús, quien hubiera podido reinar en el más suntuoso palacio de Jerusalén siendo obedecido por todos! Él, en cambio, rechazó todo esto para esconderse del mundo obedeciendo fielmente a María y a José y dedicándose a los más humildes trabajos diarios, el taller de San José y en la casa de Nazaret. Las familias de hoy, deben seguir este ejemplo tan hermoso que nos dejó Jesús tratando de imitar las virtudes que vivía la Sagrada Familia: sencillez, bondad, humildad, caridad, laboriosidad, etc. La familia debe ser una escuela de virtudes. Es el lugar donde crecen los hijos, donde se forman los cimientos de su personalidad para el resto de su vida y donde se aprende a ser un buen cristiano. Es en la familia donde se formará la personalidad, inteligencia y voluntad del niño. Esta es una labor hermosa y delicada. Enseñar a los niños el camino hacia Dios, llevar estas almas al cielo. Esto se hace con amor y cariño.

"La familia es la primera comunidad de vida y amor el primer ambiente donde el hombre puede aprender a amar y a sentirse amado, no sólo por otras personas, sino también y ante todo por Dios." (Juan Pablo II, Encuentro con las Familias en Chihuahua 1990).

Recordemos que "la salvación del mundo vino a través del corazón de la Sagrada Familia". La salvación del mundo, el porvenir de la humanidad de los pueblos y sociedades pasa siempre por el corazón de toda familia. Es la célula de la sociedad.

4. Attend preparation class for the Sacrament of Baptism.
5. Bring your child's/ren birth certificate, God parent's sacramental certificates, and permission letter from your parish (if applicable).
6. Choose appropriate Godparent(s) who is practicing the faith and is in communion with the Catholic Church.
  - Must be 16 years of age or older

  - **If the Godparent(s) is/are married**, their Marriage must have been celebrated in the Catholic Church and must **provide the Church Marriage & Confirmation Certificates.**
  - **If single**, the Godparent(s) must be living a life of Chastity and goodness and **must provide certificate of 1st Holy Communion & Confirmation.**
7. Parents must be committed to raising your child in our Catholic Faith.

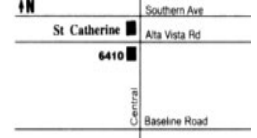

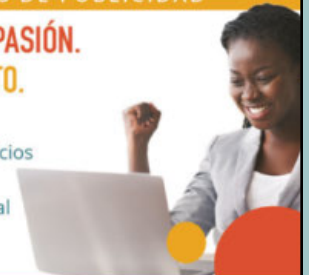
