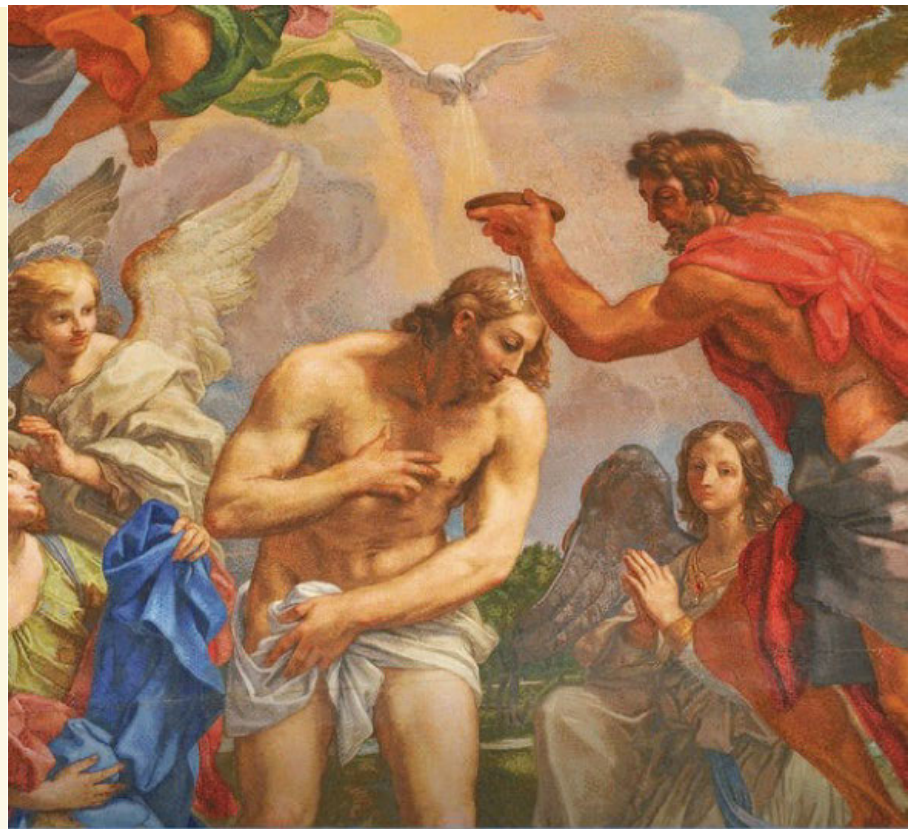

Es una historia que cubre más de 2,000 años; una historia de personas de carne y hueso que buscan a Dios y de la amorosa autorrevelación de Dios a lo largo de los siglos.

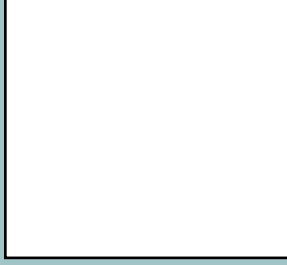
