**FROM YOUNG AT HEART SPIRITUAL CORNER:  
The Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God.**

(Galatians 4:4)

"But when the time had fully come God sent forth his Son, born of woman."

Once again we enter the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. This is among the oldest feasts associated with the Octave day of Christmas and reaffirms a basic truth that our modern society is quickly forgetting: The wholeness and integrity of persons.

As I reflect upon on the meaning of Paul's words taken from the Letter of Galatians 4:4, I ask myself about the meaning of the "fullness of time" which he speaks of making our way through history. The Gospel tells us that he was "conceived in the womb" (LK 2:21). It was there in the womb of a woman that God and mankind united never to be separated again. Salvation came forth through Mary; as a result, there is no salvation without a woman. It was in her that God was united to us. If we want to unite ourselves to him, we must take the same path through Mary, woman and mother. Something to think about, women are sources of life. Therefore every form of violence a woman is inflicted with is a blasphemy against God, who was born of woman. Let us always remember that humanity's salvation came forth from the body of a woman bring light to the love that saved us from sin. Mother Mary is the channel through which He came into the world to fulfill His mission.

Let us Pray: Mother Mary, mother of God, who gathers us together as a people of believers. We entrust this year to you. Keep us in your heart now and forever. AMEN.
