#### **Spiritual Adoption**

We welcome everyone to pray for the unborn again this year beginning March 25 (Feast of the Annunciation) to December 25 (the Birth of Jesus). We pray all children will be given life this year.

You can participate by simply praying each day for these nine months for an unborn child. While this child will remain unknown to you, his or her "spiritual parent", God knows who the child is. Many people have found that naming "their child" helps to keep them focused on the reality that their prayers are helping to save a particular baby from the harm of abortion.

You may "adopt" a child individually or as a family by signing up on our website. You will be asked the name of the child for whom you will be praying and giving the baby the humanity her or she deserves. You will become "spiritual parents" of this baby. You will be asked to pray for the unborn child and for all the unborn children. You will receive monthly reports describing your baby's development and your child will be born in 9 months.

There are millions of unborn babies desperately in need of our prayers. Won't you please prayerfully consider "spiritually adopting" one of our unborn babies and share the love of life that God has given us.

Pope Francis has asked our parish to support the Pontifical Good Friday Collection, which helps Christians in the Holy Land, where they are now less than 2% of the population. Your support is essential to help the Church minister in parishes, provide Catholic schools, and offer religious education. The Pontifical Good Friday Collection also helps to preserve the sacred shrines of Christianity, including in Jerusalem, Nazareth, and Bethlehem, to name only a few.

The pandemic hit Christians in the Holy Land particularly hard. Most of them depend on pilgrimages for work. In these times of crisis, the Pontifical Good Friday Collection is necessary to meet the basic needs of the People of God still living in this Land and to maintain a Christian presence where the Church was born.

# 55+ YOUNG AT HEART MINISTRY FROM YOUNG AT HEART SPIRITUAL CORNER: HOLY WEEK.

This Holy Week is indeed a week like no other in the year. It is a week of special celebrations on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil. Hopefully you can be present for these celebrations. This week is a week to take time out, to stop, to reflect, to spend time with Jesus who gave his life for us. It is a week to pray! Let's consider this passage from the *Gospel* of **Matthew 18:12-13.** 

"If a man has a hundred sheep, and one of them has gone astray, does he not leave the ninety-nine on the mountains and go in search of the one that went astray? And if he finds it, truly, I say to you, he rejoices over it more than over the ninety-nine that never went astray."

**Holy Thursday:** Let's share about foot washing. The special thing we do on Holy Thursday. Foot washing was a true act of service because people back then mostly wore sandals, and their feet took a beating. Their feet were dirty and had shameful cultural connotations.

**Good Friday:** Jesus was laid in the tomb. This day hits us hard because it's a story of betrayal, abuse, indifference, despair, and a brutal death. This day acknowledges grief at suffering and loss. But it's also a day when the Church says two bold, insistent things: You're never alone; and death is not the end of the story! You're never alone because in Jesus Christ, God entered into human experience, even into its darkest depths. God can always find us there and walk with us there.

**Holy Saturday:** A time of waiting: On this day Jesus is fighting evil and death, for the sake of new life for all humanity.

We often speak of ourselves as seeking God, but that's not really the way it works. According to Benedictine Mark Barrett in his book **Crossing: Reclaiming the Landscape of Our lives** says: "Biblical images of God---shepherd, farmer, lover--always make God the one who is active. He takes the initiative...God is the seeker, and we are the object of the search. This is the strangest lesson of all."

While our world seems silent and still, Our Lord is working out of our view to bring back all his lost sheep. We might want to take some time during the quit of Holy Saturday to meditate on Christ's saving action, and prepare ourselves to return to Him when the Resurrected Lord comes back for us on **EASTER SUNDAY!**
