The Twenty-Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time
El Vigésimo Séptimo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

XXVII Domingo ordinario

La lectura que tenemos de Isaías hoy se lee como una canción de amor. Dios es el viñador que construye su viña con cariño y ternura. Remueve la tierra, saca las piedras, planta parras selectas, edifica una torre para vigilar, y excava un lagar para producir vino con las uvas. Hace todo lo posible para asegurar que la viña produzca buenas uvas. Pero al final, la viña rinde uvas agrias y el viñador queda decepcionado. Al final del Evangelio, san Mateo nos dice que la gente responde a Jesús que los nuevos viñadores tendrán que entregar buenos frutos al momento de la cosecha. Nosotros vemos muy pocas viñas, pero podemos entender la parábola muy bien. Dios persigue a su pueblo, a nuestro pueblo con cariño y con ternura. Nos da sus palabras y su promesa de amor. Nos sigue perdonando e invitándonos a una intimidad con su Divina presencia. Nos da la comunidad de la Iglesia para que tengamos compañeros en el camino. Nos da ejemplos de fidelidad en nuestra familia y nuestra comunidad. Nos da amigos fieles que están enfrentando la misma realidad que nosotros y venciendo las fuerzas de destrucción. Nos da el Cuerpo y Sangre de su Hijo para fortalecernos y protegernos del mal. Nos da su promesa de que nunca estaremos solos. Y lo único que nos pide es que produzcamos buenos frutos. Estos frutos son un reflejo de Dios: cariño para los que sufren, comprensión con los débiles, paciencia con los que tienen otras ideas y maneras de vivir, fidelidad a la comunidad, afecto con los familiares, y esperanza en la palabra de Dios. Estos frutos brotan de una relación personal con un Dios de amor, el Dios que está cerca and nos trata con misericordia y ternura.

Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

The reading we have from Isaiah today reads like a love song. God is the landowner who builds his vineyard with love and tenderness. He spaded it, remove the stones, plants the choicest vines, builds a watchtower, and hewed out a wine press. He does everything possible to ensure that the vineyard produces good grapes. But in the end, the vineyard yields wild grapes, and the landowner is disappointed. At the end of the Gospel, Saint Matthew tells us that the people respond to Jesus that the new vinedressers will have to deliver good fruit at harvest time. We see very few vineyards, but we can understand the parable very well. God pursues his people, our people with love and tenderness. He gives us His words and His promise of love. He continues to forgive us and invite us into intimacy with his Divine presence. He gives us the community of the Church so that we have companions on the path. He gives us examples of faithfulness in our family and our community. He gives us faithful friends who are facing the same reality as us and overcoming the forces of destruction. He gives us the Body and Blood of his Son to strengthen us and protect us from evil. He gives us His promise that we will never be alone. And the only thing He asks of us is that we produce good fruit. These fruits are a reflection of God: affection for those who suffer, understanding with the weak, patience with those who have other ideas and ways of living, fidelity to the community, affection with family members, and hope in the word of God. These fruits spring from a personal relationship with a God of love, the God who is close and treats us with mercy and tenderness.

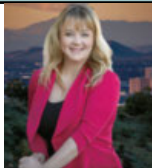
