Deacon Reflection for the week of October 22, 2023

In this Sunday's Gospel, the Pharisees tried to trap Jesus with a question about taxes. Jesus discerns the malicious intent and responds wisely, avoiding the trap, providing a distinction between civic and religious duties. How many of us are truthful in our relationship with God? How many of us as Catholics, when we were confirmed, became proclaimers of God's Word. How many are in accordance with the truth? Do you need to pick sides to feel validated by other's opinions? And, if you're not concerned with anyone's opinion, are you concerned that no one would regard a person's status. Tell us then, what is your opinion, do you take Jesus' approach to not firmly side understanding that true faith requires embracing ambiguity and not always seeking definite answers. Shouldn't we follow Christ example the way the Gospel teaches us, if you're not concerned with anyone opinion then be silent. Deacon Enrique Padilla

Jesús discierne la intención maliciosa y responde sabiamente, evitando la trampa, estableciendo una distinción entre deberes cívicos y religiosos. ¿Cuántos de nosotros somos sinceros en nuestra relación con Dios? ¿Cuántos de nosotros como católicos, cuando fuimos confirmados, nos convertimos en proclamadores de la Palabra de Dios? ¿Cuántos están de acuerdo con la verdad? ¿Necesita elegir bando para sentirse validado por las opiniones de los demás? Y, si no le preocupa la opinión de nadie, ¿le preocupa que nadie tenga en cuenta el estatus de una persona? Cuéntanos entonces, ¿cuál es tu opinión? ¿Tomas el enfoque de Jesús de no dejar de lado con firmeza la comprensión de que la verdadera fe requiere abrazar la ambigüedad y no buscar siempre respuestas definitivas? ¿No deberíamos seguir el ejemplo de Cristo como nos enseña el Evangelio? Si no te preocupa la opinión de nadie, entonces guarda silencio.


