Mondays through Friday directly after the 8:00 a.m. daily Mass, and **Saturdays** at 9:00 a.m. in the Church Confessionals.


BAPTISMS

Jesus is not calling us to be minimalist. He is calling us to love God and neighbor completely, without counting the cost.
