BAPTISMS



What to wear to Church?

People dress up for weddings, funerals, office parties and dates – but for some, dressing to meet Almighty God at Mass is a forgotten tradition. Dressing for Mass is a matter of showing respect, not only for God, but for others around you. We should never judge other people's attire, but we owe our Lord to dress our best. Remember, Mass isn't a fashion show, and all are welcome in the house of our Lord.

Below are some guidelines for proper attire:

Women:

Think modest and conservative when choosing your outfit; shoulders should be covered, necklines should be modest. Wear a shawl or sweater if needed. Hemlines should cover the knee sitting and standing.

No spaghetti straps, strapless, or crop tops.

Refrain from wearing anything transparent.

Mantillas/veils, scarves or hats are optional.

Wear your best clothes.

Slacks and a button down or collared shirt

Suit or jacket with a tie, especially nice at Christmas and Easter.

No sleeveless shirts.

No hats.

All:

Nice blue jeans (not torn and frayed).

Nice shoes, say no to the flip flops.

No shorts, yoga pants or sweats.

No tight-fitting clothing.

Mujeres:

No blusas con tirantes tipo espagueti, sin tirantes o blusas cortas.

Absténganse de vestir cualquier prenda transparente

Mantillas, velos, bufandas o sombreros son opcionales.

Hombres:

Pónganse sus mejores ropas.

Pantalones de vestir y camisa de botones of con cuello.

Traje o Saco con corbata, especialmente en Navidad y Pascua

No camisas sin mangas

No sombreros o cachuchas.

Todos:

Pantalones casuales de mezclilla (no deshilachados ni rasgados)

Cazado adecuados, no sandalias.

No shorts, no pantalones de yoga ni sudaderas

No ropa extremadamente ajustada

Mass Offerings: Ordinarily a priest may accept only one intention per Mass that he celebrates. However, canon law does permit for multiple intentions as long as those contributing toward the particular Mass all agree that there can be multiple intentions. The normal approach is to celebrate one intention per Mass and to send excess stipends (especially for Masses specifically requested on a particular day) to mission dioceses or mission parishes. In that way, the Mass is celebrated in accord with the donor's intention. However, due to the large number of Masses requested locally, please be informed that we will continue to have multiple intentions for the same Mass unless an individual indicates that the Mass may be celebrated elsewhere. Please note that in the event of multiple Mass intentions for the same Mass, the priest is permitted in canon law to receive only one of the customary ten-dollar stipends offered, with the remaining stipends going to general support of our parish. This prevents what might be viewed as combining Masses for the financial gain of the priest. While I am anxious to be of service as best I can, I would inform you that there are priests in mission parishes and mission dioceses for whom the stipend is a major source of their income. Certainly the graces that flow from the Mass are the same whether celebrated here in our parish or elsewhere. Please consider the needs and assistance you can provide to mission parishes and priests. – Fr. Jay Luczak, Pastor
