#### **BAPTISMS**



#### Reflection 1st Sunday of Advent 2023

Today's Gospel reading likewise calls us to participate actively, remaining alert for Jesus coming. A series of imperatives ("Be watchful! Be alert." Watch gives us a sense of urgency to the need to be on our guard and actively on the lookout for Jesus. Jesus describes the attitude we should have during this time between Jesus resurrection and his second coming. Jesus provides the reason we should be alert. We "don not know when the time will come." He explains further that we are not just waiting passively for his coming, rather, we have been entrusted with work. God's work. Each according to his or her ability. We are responsible for fulfilling our set tasks with implication that we will need to give an account of ourselves when Jesus returns, since he cold return at any time. We need to be prepared to recount our work for the Kingdom of God at the drop of a hat.

In today's Gospel Jesus incarnation came at the least expected time and manner possible, as a baby boy resting in a lowly manger. Will Christmas day find us ready for our Lord?
