BAPTISMS



Reflexión, II Domingo de Adviento. *Marcos 1, 1-8*

"Yo los he bautizado a ustedes con agua, pero él los bautizara con el Espíritu Santo." Este 2º domingo de Adviento nos recuerda no solo la espera de nuestro Señor Jesucristo, sino también la necesidad del bautismo en cada uno de nosotros, porque no es solo agua sino es el Espíritu Santo quien viene a los bautizados, y solo Dios mismo pudo hacer esto posible. Se necesita humildad y fe para empezar a aceptar y entender el mensaje de san Juan Bautista, por eso su predicación redunda en la virtud de la sencillez. El mismo, a pesar de ser el más grande entre los hombres - "En verdad les digo que no ha surgido entre los nacidos de mujer uno mayor que Juan el Bautista; sin embargo, el más pequeño en el Reino de los Cielos es mayor que él." Mt 11, 11 - vivió su vida en la más completa austeridad, vestido con pieles de camello, comiendo saltamontes y miel silvestre, entregado por completo a las manos de Dios para su supervivencia, predicando no solo con palabras, pero aún más: con sus acciones, y si Juan es aún menor que el mas pequeño en Cielo, ¿que podríamos esperar de nosotros que somos mil veces menores que Juan el Bautista, por así decir? La respuesta es que no podemos esperar absolutamente nada, si no hay la conversión que Juan anuncio: "Preparen el camino del Señor, enderecen sus senderos." Una vez que somos bautizados y tenemos uso de razón, es necesario darle paso a la humildad en el corazón para aceptar y confesar nuestras faltas y en verdad enderezar el sendero de nuestra vida para que nos lleve al Reino de los Cielos por obra de Cristo nuestro Señor a quien esperamos con todo el amor del que podemos ser capaces.

Reflection, II Sunday of Advent. Mark 1:1-8

"I have baptized you with water, he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit." This 2nd Sunday of Advent reminds us not only of the advent of our Lord Jesus Christ, but also of the need for baptism in each one of us, because it is not only water that we receive, but The Holy Spirit who comes to the baptized, and only God himself could make this possible. It takes humility and faith to begin to accept and understand the message of St. John the Baptist, which is why his preaching revolves around the virtue of humility. He himself, though he is the greatest among men - "Truly I say to you, among those born of women there has risen no one greater than John the Baptist; yet he who is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he." Mt 11:11 - he lived his life in the most complete austerity, dressed in camel skins, eating locust and wild honey, given completely into the hands of God for his survival, preaching not only with words, but more so: with his actions, and if John is even less than the least in Heaven, what could we expect from us who are a thousand times smaller than John the Baptist, so to speak? The answer is that we can expect absolutely nothing without the conversion that John announced: "Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths." Once we are baptized and have the use of reason, it is necessary to give way to humility in our heart to accept and confess our faults and truly straighten the path of our life so that it leads us to the Kingdom of Heaven through our Lord Christ whom we await with all the love that we can be capable of.
