BAPTISMS



DO YOU WISH TO REGISTER WITH THE PARISH?

Often people may attend Mass for several years, but never register. Registering in a parish is a declaration of your desire to be part of a Catholic community and to make a commitment to the life of Our Lady of Grace Parish community. Being a registered parishioner makes the process much easier when it is time for weddings, infant baptism, or religious education registration, when asked to be a baptismal or confirmation sponsor, and even funerals. A registered parishioner receives all parish mailings and emails. Church law advises that territories or boundaries no longer limit parish registration. Our Lady of Grace Parish accepts anyone who wants to share in the life of the parish regardless of where they live. However, the Diocese of Tucson advises that you may only choose one parish as your home parish. You may be active at as many parishes as you would like, but please choose only one parish as your home parish which will be your parish of registration (with the exception of our winter visitors of course!). It's easy to register at Our Lady of Grace Parish... just complete a registration form. Download a Registration Form from the website (homepage), and email or mail filled form back. We welcome you to register!
