#### **BAPTISMS**



# III Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Ten el valor y el coraje, así como la confianza en el Señor, para dejarlo todo por el Señor, para anunciar Su Evangelio con la radicalidad de una vida entregada totalmente a Él. Recuerda que, si el Señor te pide darlo todo por Él, ¡Él te dará cien veces más, y luego la vida eterna! (Mc 10,29-30). Confía en el Señor y no tengas miedo. Recuerda también que de la fiel respuesta a tal llamado depende tu propia felicidad y la de muchas otras personas, especialmente de tus familiares (aunque de momento ellos no lo vean así). ¡Una vocación es siempre fuente de muchas bendiciones para una familia que sabe abrirse a tan gran regalo de Dios!

# Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

The task of rescuing human beings from their deepest misery, of being a fisher of men, is very beautiful. In reality, it is the most important mission that can exist on this earth: to liberate, in a tough battle in which Victory is already ours through Jesus Christ, his human brothers from the dominion of evil, sin and death to win them for the Full life. Their task is to bring them to an encounter with the Lord Jesus, to help them reconcile with God so that they too can participate in his same divine life, in his communion in love, to help them become real men and women. Can there be a greater mission than that, which involves participating in a privileged way in the mission that God himself entrusted to his only Son, the Son of Saint Mary? If the Lord, who knows your heart, who knows what you are made for, looks at you full of love and tells you: "Come with me, and I will make you fishers of men," do not hesitate to respond. Have the courage, as well as the trust in the Lord, to leave everything for the Lord, to announce His Gospel with the radicality of a life totally given to Him. Remember that, if the Lord asks you to give everything for Him, He will give you a hundred times more, and then eternal life! (Mk 10,29-30). Trust in the Lord and do not be afraid. Also remember that your own happiness and that of many other people, especially your family members, depends on your faithful response to such a call (although at the moment they may not see it that way). A vocation is always a source of many blessings for a family that knows how to open itself to such a great gift from God!

#### HAND CARVED in BETHLEHEM

PLEASE STOP BY THE TABLES OF RELIGIOUS WARES (Nativity set, rosaries, statues, crucifixes, charms, etc.) AFTER ALL THE MASSES THE WEEK-END OF ( January 27 & 28).

Ayman Khair is representing about 180 Christian families from Bethlehem. These families have been dependent upon sales of their hand carved religious articles to tourists of the Holy Land. Due to the conflict in the Middle East and the Pandemic, tourism has been stopped completely from March 2, 2020, till February 2022, and now because of what is going on in the Holy Land tourism has stopped completely.

It is very important to support them at this critical time since they have no income and there is no tourism at all. In order to survive, they have turned to Christian communities in the United States to purchase their articles.

These hand carved religious articles are beyond description. Carved from wood of the sacred Olive tree, this workmanship has been traditional for these families for hundreds of years. It is hoped that through the efforts of Mr. Khair, these families who have little income will be able to stay living and survive in the Holy Land.

Sadly enough, the Christian population dropped from 22 % to less than 2% in the last 20 years. Thank you in advance for your support.
