Reflexión, Domingo de Resurrección 2024 Juan 20:1-9

" Then the other disciple also went in, the one who had arrived at the tomb first, and he saw and believed." The disciples were John and Peter, the Gospel says that the two ran to see the tomb of the Lord, John (the younger) arriving first, but did not enter, he waited for Peter, (the elder of the two) and did not enter until after Peter had confirmed that the Lord was not there. On January 22, 1973, the Roe vs. Wade Supreme Court decision was rendered which legalized abortion throughout the entire nine months of pregnancy.
