BAPTISMS



Reflexión, Segundo Domingo de Pascua, 2024 Juan 20,19-31 "Reciban el Espíritu Santo. A los que les perdonen los pecados, les quedaran perdonados; y a los que no se los perdonen, les quedaran sin perdonar." Hoy nos habla la Palabra de Dios directo al corazón y a la fe, dos cosas que guían nuestra vida por el camino de Dios o lejos de Dios. Reflection, Second Sunday of Easter, 2024 John 20:19-31 "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them; and whose you retain are retained." Today the Word of God speaks to us directly to the heart and to our faith, two things that guide our lives in God's way or away from God. First, the Lord Jesus Christ left them His peace, notice that He said to them "Peace be with you" twice so that they would understand the importance of the peace of Christ in the heart of every one of them, once we accept the peace of Christ, we will be able to say that we have opened our hearts to His love, and if we have His peace, we will fight for it so that nothing else will take away that peace that only He gives us. Then, He gave His disciples the power to forgive sins, sealing that gift with the Holy Spirit, so He said, "Receive the Holy Spirit." Faith brings us closer to the Lord and makes us his brothers and sisters, that is, adopted children of God. This day should remind us of the importance of the Sacrament of Confession, and at the same time it fills us with y to know that the Lord left us the forgiveness of sins through the disciples, then they conferred it on the priests so that no one would be left at that time and until the end of time without the opportunity to receive the grace of Confession. Let us pray, then, that God may work in our hearts to seek the Sacrament of Confession more frequently and that the Holy Spirit may grow even more so our faith in our Lord Jesus Christ, in whom we have placed our whole life and all our hope.
