
BAPTISMS

JUNE 2ND 2024 The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ El Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo Reflexión, Solemnidad del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo, 2024 Marcos 14, 12-16. 22-26

"Tomen: esto es mi cuerpo, esta es mi sangre, sangre de la alianza, que se derrama por todos." Toda nuestra fe como creyentes en Jesucristo, se funda en esta acción: Comer y beber el Cuerpo y la Sangre del Señor. Lo único que nos pide el Señor es que verdaderamente creamos que el pan y el vino que comemos son su Cuerpo y su Sangre. Aunque los sentidos nos dicen otra cosa, la fe nos revela la verdad. Este domingo de Corpus Christi, participamos de una manera especial, haciendo honor, adorando y orando en solemne procesión el milagro más grande en nuestra Fe Católica: la Sagrada Eucaristía, de la palabra griega: acción de gracias". "Y tomando en sus manos una copa de vino, pronunció la acción de gracias, se la dio, todos bebieron y les dijo: "Ésta es mi sangre, sangre de la alianza, que se derrama por todos." El milagro mas grande en el sentido de tener acceso directo física y espiritualmente a nuestro Señor Jesucristo en estos dos mayores dones de salvación, su Cuerpo y su Sangre. En la santa Eucaristía nuestro Señor cumple su promesa de estar con nosotros hasta el fin de los tiempos: "Y he aquí que yo estoy con ustedes todos los días hasta el fin *del mundo.*" Mt 28, 20. No son palabras figurativas ni simbólicas como algunos nos lo quieren hacer creer, por el poder del Espíritu Santo en cada iglesia en todo el mundo, todos los días está el Señor verdadera y realmente presente en toda su totalidad, cuerpo y divinidad en un pedazo de pan, y su efecto depende de cada uno de nosotros: efecto de salvación cuando lo tomamos con fe y lo adoramos como el Dios que es, y cuando se toma sin fe o sin respeto, mejor seria no tomarlo. Reflection, Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, 2024 Mark 14:12-16. 22-26

"Take it, this is my body, this is my blood, the blood of the covenant, which will be shed for many." All our faith as believers in Jesus Christ is founded on this action: Eating and drinking the Body and Blood of the Lord. All the Lord asks of us is that we truly believe that the bread and wine we eat are His Body and Blood. Although our senses tell us otherwise, faith reveals the truth to us. This Corpus Christi Sunday, we participate in a special way, honoring, worshipping and praying in a solemn procession the greatest miracle in our Catholic Faith: The Holy Eucharist, from the Greek word: thanksgiving." "Then he took a cup <u>gave thanks</u>, and gave it to them, and they all drank from it. He said to them, this is my blood, the blood of the covenant, which will be shed for many.' The greatest miracle in the sense of having direct physical and spiritual access to our Lord Jesus Christ in these two greatest gifts of salvation, His Body and **His Blood.** In the Holy Eucharist our Lord fulfills His promise to be with us until the end of time: "And behold, I am with you always, to the end of time." Mt 28:20. They are not figurative or symbolic words as some would have us believe, by the power of the Holy Spirit in every church throughout the world, always, the Lord is truly present in all his totality, body and divinity in a piece of bread, and his effect depends on each one of us: The saving effect when we take it in faith and worship it as the God that it is, and when it is taken without faith or respect, it would be better not to take it. May the Holy Spirit increase our faith and love for the Holy Eucharist and may God the Father grant us his grace and blessing in the name of his Son our Lord Jesus Christ. Deacon, Memo Castro


