The Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
El Décimo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Hoy el Evangelio según San Marcos 3, 20-35 nos presenta una enseñanza profunda sobre la voluntad de Dios. Observamos tres reacciones distintas ante Jesús, quien con su mensaje revolucionario no deja a nadie indiferente. Esta lectura se enlaza con el temor de nuestros primeros padres en el Jardín del Edén y con la exhortación de San Pablo a los Corintios a tener a Dios como el fundamento último de nuestra vida. En el Evangelio, Jesús vuelve a Nazaret y la primera reacción es la del pueblo, que se aglomera a su alrededor. La gente sencilla reconoce en Él la presencia de Dios. Este misterio divino es transparente para los humildes, como Jesús mismo alabó al Padre: «Te alabo, Padre, Señor del cielo y de la tierra, porque has ocultado estas cosas a los sabios e inteligentes y se las has revelado a la gente sencilla» (Mateo 11, 25). La segunda reacción es la de sus parientes, quienes piensan que Jesús está fuera de sí. Aquí, Jesús nos enseña que su misión trasciende las relaciones familiares. Él declara: «Mi alimento es hacer la voluntad de mi Padre» (Juan 4, 34) y añade una frase consoladora: «Quien cumpla la voluntad de Dios, ése es mi hermano, mi hermana y mi madre». Jesús así rinde homenaje a su Madre, Santa María, quien perfectamente cumple la voluntad de Dios. Finalmente, se nos abre a nosotros la posibilidad de ser considerados hermanos y hermanas de Cristo, hijos de Dios e hijos de Santa María, cumpliendo la voluntad del Padre. Que este Evangelio nos inspire a seguir el ejemplo de María, buscando siempre hacer la voluntad de Dios en nuestra vida diaria. Así, construiremos un verdadero edificio espiritual, sólido y duradero, fundamentado en el amor y la obediencia a nuestro Señor.

Today's Gospel according to Mark 3:20-35 presents us with a profound lesson about the will of God. We observe three distinct reactions to Jesus, whose revolutionary message leaves no one indifferent. This reading ties into the fear of our first parents in the Garden of Eden and Paul's exhortation to the Corinthians to have God as the ultimate foundation of our lives. In the Gospel, Jesus returns to Nazareth, and the first reaction is from the crowd that gathers around Him. The simple people recognize the presence of God in Him. This divine mystery is transparent to the humble, as Jesus Himself praised the Father: "I praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and learned and revealed them to little children" (Matthew 11:25). The second reaction comes from His relatives, who think Jesus is out of His mind. Here, Jesus teaches us that His mission transcends familial relationships. He declares, "My food is to do the will of Him who sent me" (John 4:34) and adds a comforting phrase: "Whoever does God's will is my brother and sister and mother." Jesus thus pays tribute to His Mother, Mary, who perfectly fulfills God's will. Finally, the possibility is opened for us to be considered brothers and sisters of Christ, children of God, and children of Mary, by fulfilling the Father's will. May this Gospel inspire us to follow Mary's example, always seeking to do God's will in our daily lives. In doing so, we will build a true spiritual edifice, solid and enduring, founded on love and obedience to our Lord.

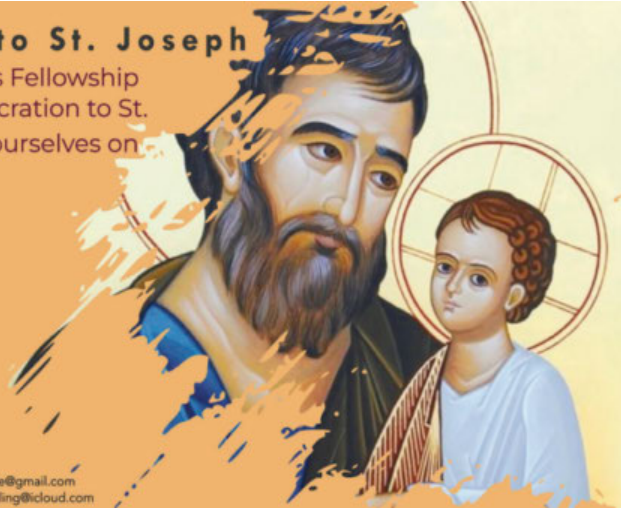

Lifteen High School Youth Group: (Grades 9-12) Open to all teens in grades 9-12 who would like to continue their Faith Formation and developing strong friendships as we continue building our relationship with Christ and His Church.
