

#### REFLECTION

Dear Parishioners,

Welcome all, especially our winter parishioners, and all who have newly arrived at St. Bridget! Traditionally the parish doubles in size at this time of year. The pandemic has changed this, but it is something to be grateful for that we can move about a little more freely. However, there is of course great concern for keeping our health. Custom lead us to celebrate this time, at the end of the Christmas season, with a pancake breakfast. Well we're cutting that back to doughnuts (remember doughnuts at mass) but the sentiment is still true. We are the baptized who belong to this body of Christ, this family, all of whom are welcomed and cherished.

The mission of Christ is ours to continue and we have committed ourselves to it in our own baptism. "Keep us," our opening collect prays, "your children born of water and the Spirit, faithful to our calling." Our own anointing makes us God's servants for the world's rescue. The power that we have for that mission is not the power of control, the power of dominion that develops into a new mode of oppression meant to bind men and women in the sinister chains of some devilish slavery masquerading as God's will for them. It is the power of the Spirit, poured out in humble service for all, and offered in joy.

Conversion is the work of God. People do not convert. They get converted. Men and women do not turn away from the way of death and destruction that they have been walking because there is some energy in them that they may call upon to do it. No! It is the power of God that turns them. It is the divine presence that breaks into their lives in an upheaval that is so transforming that, like Paul, they are thrown from their horse, as it were to find themselves confronted by the brilliant shining forth of divine radiance which makes them all "light in the Lord." The long-promised kingdom arrives in the person of Jesus Christ, meant for the transformation of the world.

Our ministry always unfolds with the full conviction that is the Lord who works in us and through us, foolish and fragile and sinful as we may be, entirely persuaded that the word of the Lord proclaimed by Isaiah describes precisely how we do it: "I have grasped you by the hand; I formed you." God leads us in ways that are not of our devising, and with a power that is divine, not ours. What we have to be involved in is not the revival of the church or the reform of the church. It has to be nothing less than what Paul and the Fathers of the Council of Jerusalem were involved in for their time-the refounding of the Catholic church for our age".



In the Angelus prayer on January 1<sup>st</sup>, the feast of Mary, Mother of God, and World Peace


