

REFLECTION

Lent 2022

Dear Parishioners,

As I have written before, lent intensifies in a special way the shape and character of the Christian life. The six weeks of the Lenten journey are meant to move us by stages more and more deeply into the mystery of Christ's dying and rising. So the liturgy is particularly careful to put emphasis on both the death and the resurrection of Christ, indicating that Christian spirituality is never content to focus on suffering and death except as the place where risen life is discovered.

The New Testament message is not that light comes only later, after a human journey of utter darkness, or that liberation is the reward for a life spent in prison, or that risen life only follows a journey "in this vale of tears" that is characterized by suffering alone. What the gospel offers is life <u>now</u> in the midst of death, light <u>now</u> in the midst of darkness, rescue n<u>ow</u> in the midst of slavery. As the blessing prayer for the ashes put it: "you do not want sinners to die but to live with the risen Christ." Lent does not ask for gloom from us ("you are not to look glum as the hypocrites do"). Lent calls us to embrace the cross of suffering and death in order to find there what Jesus found on the cross: life!

The return which Lenten conversion entails, however, is not to a God who pouts or vindictively waits to find an opportunity for counterattack. Joel proclaims: "For gracious and merciful is he, slow to anger, rich in kindness, and relenting in punishment." This is the God who reached into all the horror of Jesus' suffering and hideous death and transformed all that death into new and risen life. This is the same God to who we may bring everything of death and tragedy and corruption that is part of our own experience and fully expect that it can all be transformed, that all can be made into a new creation in the fire of God's love. Our prayer for mercy is not the whine of despair but the hope of a people who are loved: "Be merciful, Lord, for we have sinned: (responsorial).






