## ATTENTION ALL VOLUNTEERS AND MINISTERS

As we see more of you return to a ministry, we must ensure you are Safe Environment compliant.

**Safe Environment certification expires June 30, 2021.**

On July 1, 2021 the Diocese uploads the new *Safe Environment Training 2021 Online Renewal*.

**The deadline to renew the 2021 Online Renewal for the parish is September 30, 2021.**

If you did NOT complete the *2020 Online Renewal*, you must complete the *Safe Environment for Lay People Online Foundation Training* **NOW** before you can volunteer for any ministry. This must be done now so that you can renew online July 1<sup>st</sup> for the 2021-2022 year.

- The 9 AM Mass on Sundays will continue to be live-streamed on Facebook; all masses are in person, including the weekday Noon Mass

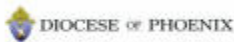

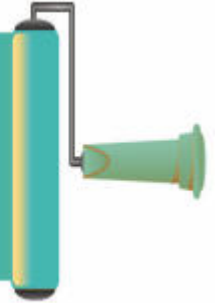

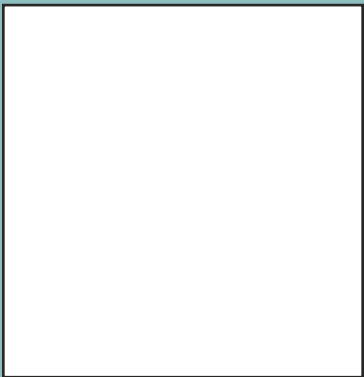
