FRANCISCAN LEGACY

Franciscan History



Toward the end of 1984, Father Warren approached Bishop Thomas J. O'Brien, the third bishop of Phoenix, with the request to seek the nomination of St. Mary's Church as a minor basilica. He judged the qualifications were present: artistic, historical, and liturgical. The bishop reacted favorably and Father Warren began to prepare the documentation. Although Brother Lawrence Flogan, OFM, had completed some of the preliminary work on this project several years earlier, no record of it could be found. So Father Warren and Bro. Joe Schwab, OFM researched and catalogues pertinent documents. The formal petition was sent to the Apostolic Delegate but was returned with the notation that the church building needed to be consecrated before the designation could or would be granted. Father Warren believed this occurred in 1881, but it had not happened. Preferring a low-key ceremony in anticipation of a solemn celebration when the title of "basilica" would be granted, Bishop O'Brien, along with Father Warren and Father Blaise Cronin, OFM, consecrated the church at the 11 o'clock parish Mass on February 3, 1985.




Bro. Gerard has been a fixture around the parish for many years. He comes and goes every few months to gather medical supplies for Guaymas, Mexico.

Fluent in Spanish, Bro. Gerard taught Spanish at St. Mary's High School in the late 1980's. You could always catch him joking with Fr. Alonso. When he is in town, he loves to joke with this alumna about wanting to converse in Spanish about "Don Quixote" (the required reading at SMHS). I have to remind him I never learned Spanish all that well in his classes!

Bro. Gerard is one of six Franciscan Friars currently in Cuba, a Marxist-Leninist Communist state. Fr. O' Conaire, a fellow Franciscan in Cuba with
Bro. Gerard, states that working in Cuba is "a vocation within a vocation." The six Friars minister to a population of roughly 50,000. His vocation in Cuba is "one of presence and accompaniment of the people by listening and creating the space for them to win back trust and keep hope alive." He is perfect for this role!
