

Franciscan History







To the delight and surprise of all involved, the nomination for Basilica status was quickly approved and St. Mary's became the 32nd minor basilica in the United States. From this time forward, the pastor became the "rector of the Basilica."

The formal celebration for the basilica designation was on Sunday, December 8, 1985, with five bishops in attendance. There was an overflow crowd of 1200 people as Metropolitan Archbishop Robert Sanchez addressed the crowd by saying that the basilica was now a sign and countersign to the civic and business community of Phoenix and now had an extra responsibility to be faithful to the Holy Father. The ceremony included a blessing of a commemorative outdoor plaque and ceremonial symbols which were literally being retrieved from the airport customs office during the actual service!

The symbols for the basilica retrieved from the airport included the ombrellone (umbrella), and the tintinnabulum (basilica bell). The umbrella stands on the altar of the church, while the tintinnabulum is in the basilica sanctuary when not in use.

Born to Eternal Life Dec 25, 1936




Rev. Monsignor Edward Gerard was ordained by Bishop John Baptiste
Salpointe in Tucson as the first Catholic priest to be ordained in Arizona. He
served Arizona in many ways from a parish in Florence, to being the vicar
general of the Arizona diocese for 30 years. He is considered the "builder of
the faith's first church in Phoenix", which is now known as St. Mary's Basilica.
In recognition of his service to the Church, he was named "Domestic Prelate"
by Pope Pius XI.

He was one of the foremost pioneer priests of Arizona, coming to this state in 1876. He traveled between Tombstone, Florence, and Phoenix by horseback to say masses. Gerard High School, a Catholic high school in Phoenix that closed in 1989, was named after him.
