

Fr John R. Muir was born in Burlington, Vermont in 1978. His family of seven moved to Phoenix in 1989 where he grew up in St Theresa Parish. He attended Arcadia High School and participated in various sports and music programs. He received his BA in Spanish and Communication Arts from Regis University in 2000. He received a BA in philosophy from St. John Vianney Seminary in Denver in 2003.

He received a Masters in Divinity and STB in Theology in 2007 from University of St. Mary of the Lake. In 2008 he received a Licentiate in Sacred Theology from the Liturgical Institute in Illinois. He served in various roles at St Joan of Arc parish in Phoenix, the Newman Center at ASU, St Rose Philippine Duchesne in Anthem, Good Shepherd Mission in New River, St. Michael and St Lucy Mission in Gila Bend, St Thomas Aquinas in Avondale, and the Office of Worship for the Diocese of Phoenix. He was appointed Vicar General and Moderator of the Curia by Bishop Dolan on January 1, 2023. He enjoys reading, jogging, cooking pasta, kickboxing, playing golf, spending time with his family and friends, and hanging out with Libby his terrier.

REV. MATT HENRY

Reverend Matt Henry

I was born in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, in 1984 but moved to Phoenix when I was six months old. So, I'm about as close to a native Arizonan as can be. I attended St. Theresa Parish and School and then graduated from Arcadia High School (the same as Father Muir!) in 2002. After high school, I went to seminary in a few different places: Minnesota, Oregon, Colorado. Bishop Olmsted ordained me a priest in 2010, and I served at Ss. Simon and Jude Cathedral and Bourgade Catholic High School before going to Rome to pursue further studies.



I came home from Rome in 2014 to be with my parents who had cancer and to become pastor at Christ the King Parish in Mesa. After my mom passed away in 2014 and my dad passed away in 2015, I was dealing with a lot of difficult things, which led me to take a break from priestly ministry. I was out of the priesthood from January 2016 to January 2023, when I was re-instated (not sure if that is the right word!) and welcomed back by Bishop Dolan. During my time away from ministry, I taught at the middle school, high school, and college level. I also pursued a PhD in English Literature from the University of Dallas, and am currently working on my dissertation. I am a bona fide nerd! I am writing my dissertation on the Jesuit priest and poet Gerard Manley Hopkins (check out his amazing poetry!), and so you will probably hear me quote from his poetry often in my homilies. I could not be happier to be coming back to Phoenix after four years in Dallas and coming back to ministry at the Basilica. As a Phoenician, I have always known about St. Mary's Basilica and can't believe that I get to serve here. Thank you all (in Texas, y'all) for welcoming me here.




