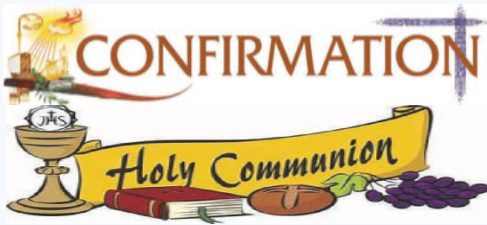
CAST THE NET OVER THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE BOAT

Between Easter and Pentecost, we shall be reading a lot about the post resurrection encounters between Jesus and His disciples. These appearances of Christ to the Apostles and to other disciples not only provides concrete proof of the resurrection but also enabled Jesus to impact essentially important lessons, empower His disciples and to set them on the path to proselytizing people to the way. Recall that on Easter morning, He had asked Mary of Magdala to direct His Apostles to meet Him in Galilee where most of them were first called to become fishers of men. While they were there, Simon Peter felt the need to go fishing and made his intentions known to the others who accompanied him. This suggests an inherently instinctive tendency we all possess to recoil into our comfort which may be an old vice whenever we are challenged by turbulent times. In moments of grief, disappointment, separation, sickness, etc, we have the instinctive tendency to temporarily return to our old way of life for comfort, like Simon the fisherman returned to fishing forgetting that by making him a fisher of men, Christ had replaced his former occupation with a kingdom vocation. Peter and his companions who had pre-discipleship occupational fishermen among them failed to catch anything from the sea of Tiberias even after trying all night. They realized why when day broke and after they encountered Jesus. Their lives had been configured to Christ alone and so they were bound to fail at achieving any goals that were not set for them by Christ's directives. Jesus had to appear to them and after prompting them to admit their limitations, directed them to "cast the net over the right side of the boat and you will find something" for them to learn this important lesson. When they met unimaginable success, they realized "it is the Lord." It is worth noting that the simple obedience to the directive of Christ made the miraculous catch possible. By virtue of our baptism, each of us have acquired an ontological connection to Christ, to those who believe He has given power to be children of God (John 1:12). Thus our task of proselytizing the kingdom of God on earth and even our daily attempt to live the Christian life shall remain abysmally unsuccessful if we elect to do it on our own. But if we allow Christ and His word to prompt every thought, word and action of ours in uncomplaining obedience, we shall find true and lasting success. This revelation of the resurrected Christ is closely followed by a dialogue between Jesus and Peter where Christ provided His designated leader of the Apostles and of the Church an opportunity to renounce his renunciation three times as he had denied Jesus three times. After Peter professed his love of Christ, Jesus commissioned him to "feed my sheep", a biblical metaphor that clearly suggests Peter's primacy in teaching, governing and sanctifying the new Israel, the Body of Christ. Through the merits of Christ, God gives us multiple opportunities of reconciliation with Him and our neighbor. If we admit our sinfulness and declare our need for His mercy, we are sure to be met by a merciful and loving Father who shall restore us to righteousness again through the merits of His Son and by the power of the Holy Spirit.

As the Holy conclave begins in Rome to elect the universal pastor of the Church and successor to the seat of St Peter, let us join the universal Church to ask the Lord to choose for His Church a shepherd after God's heart, a disciple who will feed and tend the sheep of Christ with compassion and kindness and a servant of God's servants who will preside over the earthly manifestation of God's Kingdom in love.
