Did you know?

Fr. Michael J. McGivney, founder of the Knights of Columbus, has a connection with St. Joseph as his middle name was **Joseph**. So, what did they have in common?

Both were **guardians of the family**, St. Joseph for the Holy Family, and Fr. McGivney by founding the Knights of Columbus to serve as a safe haven, promoting the faith and providing financially for Catholic families threatened by the devastation that otherwise would have occurred in the event of the death of the family wage earner.

Also, both were men of **obedience**, docile to God’s will, and, as the pope stated, were men with “**creative courage**,” that virtue where, “in the face of difficulty, we can either give up and walk away, or somehow engage with it.” He (the pope) continued, “At times, difficulties bring out the resources we did not even think we had.”

North Dakota March for Life Pilgrimage—The March for Life is an inspiring, peaceful, vibrant, and joy-filled rally of women, men, young people, and children from all across the country. Every year, tens of thousands of pro-lifers converge on the National Mall and march on Capitol Hill on the anniversary of the Supreme Court's 1973 Roe v. Wade ruling which legalized abortion in all 50 states. It's the largest annual human rights demonstration in the world. This year, the Diocese of Bismarck is planning the second annual local North Dakota March for Life on Friday, January 21, 2022. The Schedule includes Mass with Bishop Kagan at 10:30 a.m. at Cathedral of the Holy Spirit, and then a march from Cathedral following Mass to the ND State Capitol. A rally at the State Capitol steps will begin at 12:30 p.m. with speakers and a moment of silence for the 62+ million aborted babies since January 22, 1973. The event is open to the public and all are encouraged to attend! In case of inclement weather, alternate plans will be posted on the diocesan website. Mid-Winter Powwow to raise cultural awareness and benefit the Catholic Indian Mission—To kick off the University of Mary's inaugural celebration of Life & Dignity Week, on Sunday, January 16, the Mid-Winter Powwow—which had been an annual event through the 1980s and early 90s—will once again be hosted on the UMary campus. All are welcome to attend end this event, beginning with the Black Elk Mass (named for Servant of God, Nicholas Black Elk, a Lakota man whose cause for canonization was recently opened), celebrated at 10:30am in the McDowell Activity Center (MAC), continuing with an introduction to the Powwow—"Powwow 101"—in Lumen Vitae University Center's Founders Hall at 11:30am, and culminating with the Mid-Winter Contest Powwow in the MAC, with grand entries at 1pm and 7pm. There will also be a Buffalo Feed from 5-7pm in the Crow's Nest Campus Restaurant, included with the cost of admission (\$5 for those between the ages of 5 and 65). Proceeds from the event will be donated to support the efforts of the Diocese of Bismarck's Catholic Indian Mission, which consists of three parishes, a parochial school, and a childcare center on the Standing Rock Indian Reservation in south-central North Dakota. Altogether, the Catholic Indian Mission seeks to meet the spiritual needs of the people of Sioux County. For more information about the Mid-Winter Powwow, visit umary.edu/powwow.

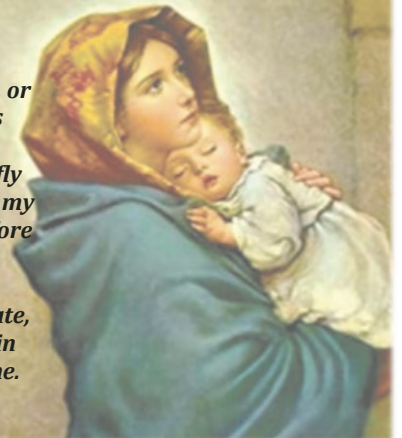

GOSPEL MEDITATION

"We are called to live our baptism every day, as new creatures, clothed in Christ."

~Pope Francis

What reference point do you use when making decisions? Many times, impulse takes control and decisions are made based solely on emotion and desire. We all know that these types of decisions can often get us into trouble. When a person has a confident sense of who they are and a real understanding of what is important and of value, the likelihood of kneejerk impulsive choices diminishes. Baptism gives us what we need to make well informed and purposeful decisions. By this simple gesture, God claims us as His own and provides us with the identity and purpose we need to properly live life.

It is tremendously reassuring, when we truly embrace this revelation and realize that we no longer have to wonder about the purpose of our lives or struggle to find our way. The answer of who we are in God has been given to us. We no longer have to fumble around, trip over ourselves or walk aimlessly about. Issues surrounding the sacredness of life, the meaning of death, the protection of those most vulnerable, care for the weak and the poor, offering hospitality to those in search of a home, the purpose and proper place of work, how to create a just social order, caring for creation, and understanding our roles as heralds and stewards are just a few of the wonderful gifts baptism brings. When we make decisions based on things such as these core Gospel truths we really act as Christ himself, revealing to others the new creations that we are. This is how we live our baptism.

It is difficult to walk against the tide. Yet, that is precisely what baptism calls us to do. Although we are sinners, in need of mercy and far from perfection we are called to order our life and make decisions based upon the wisdom and guidance of Almighty God. He alone is the one who can claim us as His sons and daughters. Standing up for our principles will not make us popular. But who ever said Christianity is a popularity contest? Baptism calls us to stand up for that which goes against the grain of secularism. Standing in line with other sinners, we have our anchor to steady us in the tempests of life and God is very pleased. Forge ahead. There is nothing to fear.
