

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

Our parishes will be conducting the national collection for the Church in Latin America and the Caribbean, the weekend of January 22/23, 2022. This national collection supports many pastoral projects that benefit the faithful in Latin America and the Caribbean.

Brazil's Associacao do Sementes do Verbo (Seeds of the Word Community) is a young and growing congregation with a unique vision of forming missionary communities of disciples in all states of life—consecrated men and women, clergy, lay missionaries, and married couples and families, all living together in community. A central aspect of the group's spirituality is a nine-month formation period called a "sabbatical year," during which participants live in a mission house with the community and study Scripture; take courses in the theology of the body and human sexuality, with an emphasis on prevention of abuse; and participate in spiritual exercises and parish mission weeks.

Supported by a grant from the Subcommittee on the Church in Latin America, 100 participants from 25 dioceses in 11 Brazilian states had the opportunity to become formed as more effective missionary disciples in 2021. When you support the Collection for the Church in Latin America, your material gift makes it possible for disciples to use their gifts and abilities as evangelizers, regardless of their states in life or economic backgrounds.

Please be generous toward the collection. Take this opportunity to share your faith with our sisters and brothers in Latin America and the Caribbean. Your support truly makes a difference. Thank you, and God bless you.

# This Week's Message From Our Priests



Jesus worked his first miracle at a wedding, and his mother, Mary, asked him to do it. This sign is very striking. Jesus did not begin his public ministry with some solemn miracle in the Temple of Jerusalem. Jesus came to help people wherever they needed it.

And a wedding is a place of joy, happiness, and hope.

Sometimes our life is like the wedding at Cana: it runs out of wine, that is, without joy, without hope. The monotony of our daily life, the continuous problems that arise, the difficulties that we must overcome ... little by little they are sapping us inside until one day we realize that we are stuck in sadness and hopelessness. And we think that God has abandoned us - maybe God does not exist.

At such times it is a great idea to ask the Virgin Mary for help.

She, as in the wedding at Cana, knows well what our problem is, and asks her Son for the solution. When we pray closely with Mary, she never fails us.

Sometimes the solution is not immediate, or it does not turn out as we expected.

But the truth is that, sooner or later, in one way or another, thanks to her intercession, we receive an answer to our prayer.

Spiritual teachers tell us that times of crisis are opportunities that God gives us to mature inwardly and draw closer to Him. No matter how painful it is, it is important to never stop praying. Although sometimes this is difficult, with the help of our Mother, the Virgin Mary, we will pass through the difficult time. We will come out of the crisis stronger.

I have been praying the rosary daily for more years than I can remember. I encourage you to pray the rosary each day... in your car, at the gym, on a walk... anywhere. Meditate on the joyful, sorrowful, luminous, and glorious mysteries of life. Jesus, Mary, and the Church are with you through it all!







**Mensaje Semanal de Nuestros Sacerdotes** 

Jesús obró su primer milagro en una boda, y su madre, María, le pidió que lo hiciera. Este signo es maravilloso.

Jesús no comenzó su ministerio público con algún milagro solemne en el Templo de Jerusalén.

Jesús vino a ayudar a las personas dondequiera que lo necesitaran. Y una boda es un lugar de alegría, felicidad y esperanza.

A veces nuestra vida es como la boda de Caná: se queda sin vino, es decir, sin alegría, sin esperanza. La monotonía de nuestro día a día, los continuos problemas que surgen, las dificultades que debemos superar... poco a poco nos van minando por dentro hasta que un día nos damos cuenta de que estamos atrapados en la tristeza y la desesperanza. Y pensamos que Dios nos ha abandonado, tal vez Dios no existe.

En esos momentos es una gran idea pedir ayuda a la Virgen María. Ella, como en la boda de Caná, sabe bien cuál es nuestro problema, y pide la solución a su Hijo. Cuando rezamos de cerca con María, ella nunca nos falla. A veces la solución no es inmediata, o no sale como esperábamos. Pero lo cierto es que, tarde o temprano, de una forma u otra, gracias a su intercesión, recibimos respuesta a nuestra oración.

Los maestros espirituales nos dicen que los tiempos de crisis son oportunidades que Dios nos da para madurar interiormente y acercarnos a Él. No importa cuán doloroso sea, es importante nunca dejar de orar. Aunque a veces esto sea difícil, con la ayuda de nuestra Madre, la Virgen María, atravesaremos el momento difícil. Saldremos de la crisis más fuertes.

He estado rezando el rosario diariamente por más años de los que puedo recordar. Los animo a rezar el rosario todos los días... en tu carro, en el gimnasio, en una caminata... en cualquier lugar. Medita en los misterios gozosos, dolorosos, luminosos y gloriosos de la vida. ¡Jesús, María y la Iglesia están contigo a través de todo!
