In 1531, a baptized Aztec Indian peasant named Juan Diego was walking on the hill of Tepeyac in the dead of winter, when he saw the apparition of a brown-skinned young girl. Speaking to him in his native tongue, she asked him to visit the local bishop and tell him that the Virgin Mary wanted a church built in her honor on the hill. Juan Diego did what he was told, visiting the local archbishop several times, but each time the bishop rejected his story.

Upon Juan Diego’s last visit to the hill, Mary told him to gather roses in a different part of the hill – roses that could not possibly be growing at that time of the year. To his surprise, the roses were exactly where she said, and he gathered them up in his tilma (a cloak-like poncho) and carried them to the bishop. When he laid the flowers at the feet of the bishop, the front of his tilma was adorned by the image of the Virgin de Guadalupe, and the bishop was convinced of the miracle of her sighting.

This sacred image of Our Lady of Guadalupe is the only physical manifestation the Holy Virgin has ever given the world. The Aztecs believed in many gods so Our Lady revealed herself in clothing that would have meaning for the Aztecs while still representing her Jewish culture.

The appearance of Our Lady of Guadalupe generated the conversion of Mexico and Central and South America to Catholicism. Today, she is not only patroness of Mexico but also Empress of the Americas, from Chile to Canada, including the United States. This manifestation of Mary is the only one to reign over two continents.

The Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe, located near the hill of Tepeyac in Mexico City, is one of the most important pilgrimage sites of Catholicism, It houses the actual cloak of Juan Diego and is visited by several million people every year, especially around December 12, the feast day of Our Lady of Guadalupe.



We will be holding the celebration of our Lady of Guadalupe on the 11th of December at 11am. With a reception at the parish office with food and beverages, Mariachis will be here to help us celebrate. We invite all St Rose parishioners to attend and help us make this celebration a great one!

Are You Smarter Than Our Teenagers?

Our St. Rose Youth program held another Mystery Saint Movie Night on Saturday, November 13th at 6 PM. They didn't know who their Mystery Saint was, but we gave them these clues:

Clue 5: I'm not an actual canonized Saint, but I was a Catholic priest from Ireland who served in the Vatican as the head of the Curia and chaplain to Pope Pius XII during World War II.

Clue 6: I'm not an actual canonized Saint, but I was very creative. I donned many disguises to sneak around Rome during World War II to organize the Resistance and save over 6,500 Jews and escaped Allied POW's from the Gestapo.




