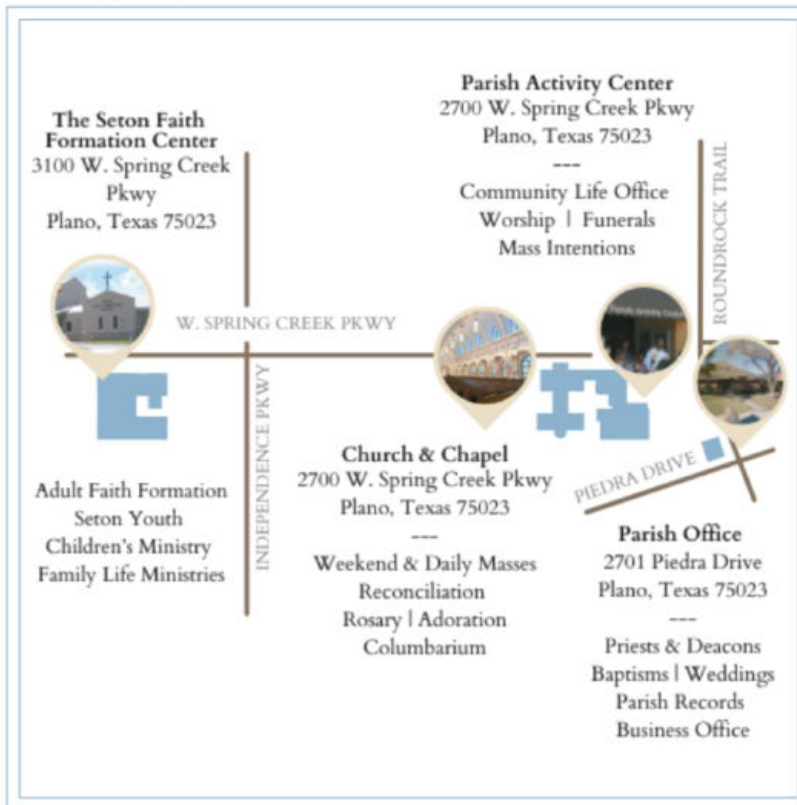

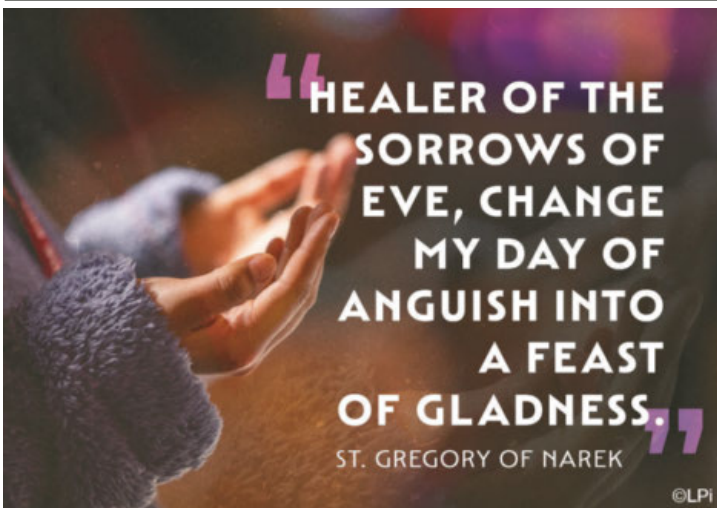


Taizé Prayer



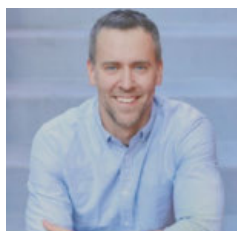
