

#### FROM DEACON TOM

A Report to the Parish on the Synod Listening Process by Deacon Burns

The Synod Listening Process requested by the Archdiocese to assess how the church is moving together to a goal of inclusiveness and participation began in March and concluded in April with a report to the Archdiocese. Two sessions were planned and written input invited by the parishioners.

I intend over the course of weeks to summarize the discussions and written input beginning today that took place then to apprise you of the topics reviewed and the suggestions received. In this first article I will list the questions the Archdiocese wished attention to be directed toward. The next article I will begin to provide the input received question by question.

These are the questions of the Archdiocese: Synodal Questions

1. Top five insights from the question: How is the church moving together? How are we a synodal church of Communion, Participation and Mission?

2. Top five insights from the question: What steps is the Spirit inviting us to take as we journey together into the future? What can we do to journey together better as a synodal church?

3. Additional insights from your sessions.

The emphasis of the Archdiocese is on "insights" gained from the experience. The process was (and is) a bottom – up direction not a top – down one. As you notice the Archdiocese wanted a report of at least ten to fifteen insights. My report to you may stress some of the insights gained but not all.

## **Eucharistic Adoration**

The importance of Eucharistic Adoration is shown in the fact that the Church has a ritual that regulates it: the Rite of Eucharistic Exposition and Benediction. This is an extension of the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament which occurs in every Mass: "Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb." Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament flows from the sacrifice of the Mass and serves to deepen our hunger for Communion with Christ and the rest of the Church. The Rite concludes with the ordained minister blessing the faithful with the Blessed Sacrament. (USCCB website)

It is called Eucharist, because it is an action of thanksgiving to God. (CCC, no. 1328)

For the Month of July and August 2022 Eucharistic Adoration

The Catechism quotes Pope John Paul II: "The Church and the world have a great need for Eucharistic worship. Jesus awaits us in this sacrament of love. Let us not refuse the time to go to meet him in adoration, in contemplation full of faith, and open to making amends for the serious offenses and crimes of the world. Let our adoration never cease." (CCC, 1380)

Spending time in Eucharistic Adoration with our Divine Lord and Friend is a good place to go to ask what he wants with our life. Why not spend some time each week in adoration, in union, in contemplation of the Lord present in the Eucharist? (USCCB)
