Message from Fr. Rodolfo Caballero



Dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

On January 16th, this past Sunday, the United States commemorated Religious Freedom. In anticipation to the annual commemoration that day, the Committee Chair of the US Conference of Bishops for religious freedom, Cardinal Timothy M. Dolan, issued a reflection on religious liberty (www.usccb.org/news/2022/us-bishops-religious-liberty-committee-chairman-offers-reflection-religious-freedom-day). We remember particularly the atrocious assault on the statue of our Lady of Fatima at the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington DC, this past December 5th, 2021. In it, Card. Dolan, shares the phenomenon that has sprung up in the last two days of religious vandalism. These attacks not only reflect a certain antagonism against a particular religion or religious creed, but also an affront to the human spirit, which nurtures a vital and essential relationship with the divinity and strives to search after God, the truth that He brings and a consequential way of life.

As we know, religious freedom is a basic human right which should be respected by everyone. On our part, we should respect others' manifestations of religiosity. Furthermore, we are called to make every effort to adequate our lives to that truth which Christian Revelation has been handed down to us by means of our Catholic Church. Religious freedom is an active attitude, not a laissez-faire response to Jesus's call to embrace his way of life.

Queridas hermanas y hermanos en Cristo,

El 16 de enero, este pasado domingo, los Estados Unidos conmemoraron la Libertad Religiosa. Anticipándose a la conmemoración anual de ese día, el presidente del Comité de la Conferencia Episcopal de Estados Unidos para la Libertad Religiosa, el cardenal Timothy M. Dolan, publicó una reflexión sobre la libertad religiosa. Recordamos especialmente el atroz asalto a la estatua de la Virgen de Fátima en el Santuario Nacional de la Inmaculada Concepción en Washington DC, el pasado 5 de diciembre de 2021. En él, el Card. Dolan comparte el fenómeno que ha surgido en los últimos dos años de vandalismo religioso. Estos ataques no sólo reflejan un cierto antagonismo contra una religión o un credo religioso en particular, sino también una afrenta al espíritu humano que alimenta una relación vital y esencial con lo divino y se esfuerza por buscar a Dios, la verdad que Él trae, y un modo de vida consecuente.

Como sabemos, la libertad religiosa es un derecho humano básico que debe ser respetado por todos. Por nuestra parte, debemos respetar las manifestaciones de religiosidad de los demás. Además, estamos llamados a esforzarnos por conformar nuestra vida a esa verdad de la Revelación cristiana que ha sido transmitida por medio de nuestra Iglesia católica. La libertad religiosa es una actitud activa, no una respuesta de laissez-faire a la llamada de Jesús a abrazar su forma de vida.

THE ART OF REALLY LISTENING

Have you ever reflected on how many times in the Bible we hear of God's listening? In Exodus 2:24 we read how God heard their groaning and he remembered his covenant with Abraham, with Isaac and with Jacob. "Through his prophet Isaiah God said, "Before they call I will answer; while they are still speaking I will hear." (Isaiah 65:24) And we see too how Jesus called upon His Father, thanking Him, asking Him to heal, to have mercy, to take away this cross, and then placing it all in His Father's hands.

Sometimes we wish we could do something for those around us who are hurting. But perhaps, though it may not seem like much, all we are called to do at the moment is to "be quick to listen, slow to speak" (James 1:19a). God can work through our caring listening like a soothing salve on a wound, bringing about healing, deeper self-understanding, and the abundant life that Jesus promised.

Listening is an essential part of Stephen Ministry. Stephen Ministers use active listening skills to help people recognize and accept the feelings they are experiencing. 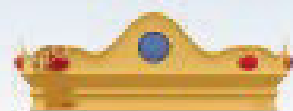
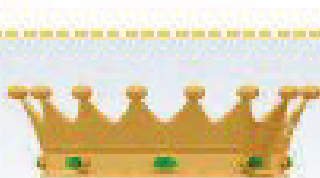

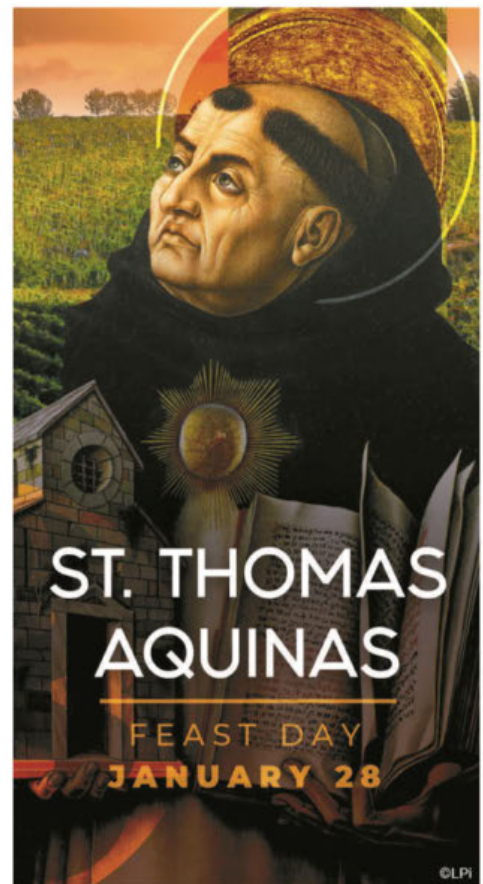

LIVE THE LITURGY Inspiration for the week

People can easily lose a sense of the sacred and transcendent. When we lose a sense of God's special presence, we need to be brought back. Ezra brought people back to the word of God and they realized what they were missing. Jesus proclaims God's word in the synagogue with true conviction and tells those gathered that he is the fulfillment of all that Isaiah taught. Even though people get lost, distracted, discouraged, and often journey down the wrong path, God's timeless law remains. When we allow ourselves to truly hear God's word and act on it, that living word slowly, over time, changes us. It has the power to soften and mold us, creating within us a joyful spirit. We realize the truth in what God speaks and become open to God's love. Gradually and gently God leads us back where we belong. We discover again the sacred character of life and the wonder of God's power. It is no wonder that Luke addresses his remarks to Theophilus. It is a name that means "beloved of God," a name that can be used by anyone who desires friendship with God.



ST. THOMAS AQUINAS

SAINT OF THE WEEK

One of the most famous members of the Dominican Order, St. Thomas Aquinas (1225 – 1274) is well-known by many for his theological work, "The Summa Theologiae." Born in Italy, his mother wanted him to become a Benedictine and had high hopes that he would eventually become abbot of Monte Cassino, where he spent much of his youth. To change his vocation, she had him kidnapped by his brothers on his way to Paris at the age of 19. He spent two years in their captivity. Despite this, nothing could shake him from his vocation to become a Dominican priest and he was eventually released. Once free, he went to Paris and then to Cologne, where he finished his studies with Albert the Great.

His greatest contribution to the Catholic Church is his writings. The unity, harmony, and continuity of faith and reason, of revealed and natural human knowledge, encompasses his writings. The Summa Theologiae, his last and, unfortunately, uncompleted work, deals with the whole of Catholic theology.

The patron saint of teachers, theologians and students, St. Thomas Aquinas died in 1274. His life and the impact he had on the whole Church, however, remains alive today.

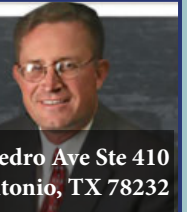

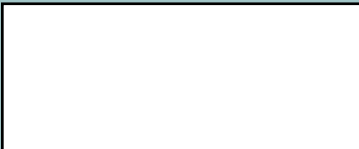
