

#### Message from Fr. Rodolfo Caballero

Dear sisters and brothers in Christ.



The first reading in the liturgy this weekend talk about something that could not be more consoling, God's love expressed in the foreknowledge of our being and our consecration to Him by the shear fact of being created by him: "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I dedicated you, a prophet to the nations I appointed you". Seeing evil around us and sin within us, we may forget that message more often than we would wish. However, the Lord is constant in reminding us this hopeful truth. St. Joh Vianney, the Curé of Ars, would say that if we were to know how much God loves us, we would die. If we take a look at the Catechism of the Catholic Church, we would read the following: "Jesus makes charity the new commandment. By loving his own 'to the end,' he makes manifest the Father's love which he receives. By loving one another, the disciples imitate the love of Jesus which they themselves receive. Whence Jesus says: 'As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you; abide in my love.' And again: 'This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you.' (nn. 1823-1829). That is why, the

most logical consequence of realizing how much God loves us is to love one another. Hence, the second reading: "Strive eagerly for the greatest spiritual gifts.

But I shall show you a still more excellent way... Love is patient, love is kind. It is not jealous, it is not pompous, It is not inflated, it is not rude, it does not seek its own interests, it is not quick-tempered, it does not brood over injury, it does not rejoice over wrong-doing but rejoices with the truth. It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things... Love never fails... So faith, hope, love remain, these three; but the greatest of these is love".

May we continually delve and live in the mystery God's love, in order for that love to overflow in our dealings with others, in our family, in our Parish Community, towards all we meet. Let us pray for one another in that same spirit of love that the Lord Jesus has taught us.

#### Mensaje de Fr. Rodolfo Caballero

Queridas hermanas y hermanos en Cristo,

La primera lectura de la liturgia de este fin de semana habla de algo que no puede ser más consolador: el amor de Dios expresado en el conocimiento previo de nuestro ser y nuestra consagración a Él por el mero hecho de haber sido creados por Él. "Desde antes de formarte en el seno materno, te conozco; desde antes de que nacieras, te consagré como profeta para las naciones." Al ver el mal que nos rodea y el pecado que llevamos dentro, podemos olvidar ese mensaje más a menudo de lo que desearíamos. El Señor, sin embargo, es constante en recordarnos esta verdad esperanzadora. San Juan Vianney, el cura de Ars, decía que si supiéramos cuánto nos ama Dios, nos moriríamos. Si consultamos al Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, leeremos lo siguiente: "Jesús hace de la caridad el mandamiento nuevo (cf Jn 13, 34). Amando a los suyos "hasta el fin" (Jn 13, 1), manifiesta el amor del Padre que ha recibido. Amándose unos a otros, los discípulos imitan el amor de Jesús que reciben también en ellos. Por eso Jesús dice: "Como el Padre me amó, yo también os he amado a vosotros; permaneced en mi amor" (Jn 15, 9). Y también: "Este es el mandamiento mío: que os améis unos a otros como yo os he amado" (Jn 15, 12)" (CIC 1823). Por eso, la consecuencia más lógica de comprender cuánto nos ama Dios es amarnos unos a otros. De ahí la segunda lectura:

"Aspiren a los dones de Dios más excelentes. Voy a mostrarles el camino mejor de todos... El amor es comprensivo, el amor es servicial y no tiene envidia; el amor no es presumido ni se envanece; no es grosero ni egoísta; no se irrita ni guarda rencor; no se alegra con la injusticia, sino que goza con la verdad. El amor disculpa sin límites, confía sin límites, espera sin límites, soporta sin límites. El amor dura por siempre... Ahora tenemos estas tres virtudes: la fe, la esperanza y el amor; pero el amor es la mayor de las tres.

Que profundicemos y vivamos continuamente en el misterio del amor de Dios, para que ese amor se desborde en nuestra familia, en nuestra comunidad parroquial y hacia todos los que encontramos. Recemos unos por otros con ese mismo espíritu de amor que el Señor Jesús nos ha enseñado.

Bendiciones para usted y para cada miembro de su familia, especialmente para los enfermos y los ancianos. Su hermano y servidor en el sacerdocio de Jesucristo.

My Jesus, when I look at this life of souls, I see that many of them serve You with some mistrust. At certain times, especially when there is an opportunity to sow their love for God, I see them running away from the battlefield. And once Jesus said to me, **Do you, my child, also want to act like that?** I answered the Lord, "Oh, no, my Jesus, I will not retreat from the battlefield even if mortal sweat breaks out on my brow; I will not let the sword fall from my hand until I rest at the feet of the Holy Trinity! Whatever I do, I do not rely on my own strength, but on God's grace. With God's grace a soul can overcome the greatest difficulties. (#287)

## Divorced & Separated Ministry WHAT WOULD JESUS DO?

In the past, someone posted a very moving plea on the divorcedcatholic.org forum. Here is an excerpt from the post:

"I am so sorry for what I have done, but the guilt and heartache over what I have done is crushing me and I want so desperately to reconcile with God and the Church."

Their pain, caused by their own mistake, is so evident.

When dealing with the fallout of divorce, we often seek justice by blaming the offending party. We tend to mentally banish that person to a life of shame. After all, that is their just reward. Right? Well, what would Jesus do?

The Gospel story of the woman caught in adultery (John 8:2-11) gives clear insight into Jesus's merciful heart. When the woman caught in the act of adultery is brought to Jesus, the Pharisees are certain Jesus will condemn her to death by stoning as the Mosaic law dictates. However, Jesus shocks them by turning the spotlight on their own sinfulness. One by one, they retreat in shame. Jesus then forgives the woman, and instructs her to "Go, and sin no more."

This is the model of mercy and forgiveness we are all called to follow. If your divorce was caused by your ex, you are called to forgive them and release them from their guilt and shame. If you were the person who caused your divorce, come to Jesus, and know that He stands ready to forgive you, not condemn you. As Jesus made clear to the Pharisees, none of us is perfect. We are all sinners in need of forgiveness. Thankfully, we have a Savior, Jesus, who is always ready to forgive even our most dreadful sins. Go to Him!

For there is no distinction; since all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, they are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus. - Romans 3:22-24

#### SOMETIMES IT'S HARD TO ASK FOR HELP



#### LIVE THE LITURGY

#### Inspiration for the week

Prophets possess an intimate knowledge of God and act on their experience of God. Prophetic messages usually challenge the status quo and draw us up and out of ourselves, focusing us on the bigger picture. We often think of ourselves and our own needs first. When we listen to someone speak, we judge the merit of the message by its degree of usefulness. If the message or vision contains no personal benefit or profit but a call to stretch and grow, we can become indignant. Prophets are usually the ones whose message challenges us and calls us to see things differently and love more perfectly and deeply. God is love. When listening to St. Paul speak about love we witness the unfolding of this type of unconditional, other centered, self-sacrificial perfect God. It is an invitation to life, freedom, and happiness that can be offered to us only by God. Jesus, who is God and Love incarnate, calls us to this richer expression of love. Are we ready to listen and be challenged and stretched?



#### SAINT OF THE WEEK

You may be familiar with the annual "blessing of throats" that many parishes in the United States use to commemorate the beloved bishop and martyr. St. Blaise lived in the fourth century in Turkey and Armenia. Due to religious persecution, he was forced to flee and hide in a cave in the back country in order to save his life.

History has it that one day a group of hunters stumbled upon where St. Blaise was living. They found the bishop kneeling in prayer, surrounded by wolves, lions and bears that he had tamed. The legend has it that as the hunters dragged Blaise off to prison, a mother came with her young son who had a fish bone lodged in his throat. At Blaise's command, the child was able to cough up the bone and thus lived.

Today we remember the saint on his feast day by taking two candles, crossing them against the throat, and saying the following prayer:

Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from ailments of the throat and from every other evil. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.


