

## Message from Fr. Rodolfo Caballero



We have about one week left from the most solemn of all the weeks of the year: Holy Week. But before that, let us consider today's gospel, the last one of this period of Lent, to see what the Lord wants to tell us. It is about the woman caught in flagrant adultery. The enemies of the Lord want to put him to the test, but Jesus's answer is magnificent, not only to them, but to us also: "Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her". Following this principle, Jesus would have had the right to throw a stone at her. But He didn't. On the contra-

ry, He forgave her and warned her not to sin any more. May this Holy Week help us consider God's infinite love in the mercy that He shows to us, and may we always turn to Him to move away from anything that hurts Him and which hurts our dignity as human beings.

May the Lord continue to bless you and each member of your family, especially the ill and the elderly.







## **Divorced & Separated Ministry**

### SPIRITUAL FITNESS

Living the truth of our faith can be very difficult. We are all guilty of trying to modify a teaching of our faith to make it easier to live. It could be the Church's teaching on sexual morality, or marriage, or receiving the Sacraments. Unfortunately, when we do this, it stunts our growth toward holiness and limits our spiritual maturity. It is like cheating at working out. Who am I really hurting? ME! Worse, I am lying to myself by thinking I am improving my life when I am actually hurting myself.

Not living the truth causes you to avoid modifying those behaviors in your life that are leading you toward sin and away from Christ. Using the workout analogy, by cheating on your workouts, you are not receiving the health benefits because you did not endure the pain required to build muscle or burn fat. You are kept weak, and your physical growth is stunted. The same is true in your spiritual life. Had you lived in the truth, you would have made different decisions, made the character changes necessary to fulfill them, grown in maturity and ability, and drawn closer to God. (This is always the fruit of living in the truth.)

What truth are you not living fully? Pray for the graces needed to obtain the courage to take the bold steps needed to fully live the truth of your Catholic faith. While this can be very difficult, the fruit will be abundant peace and joy.

"But whoever lives the truth comes to the light, so that his works may be clearly seen as done in God." - John 3:21

## DOES ANYBODY HEAR ME?

Think about this. How many times when somebody is grieving a loss or has a problem do we actually just listen? Most of us don't. We try and solve it. But Stephen Ministry training teaches that often what is needed most is a person to just sit and listen to the hurting individual and hold that person in God's love. 



## St. Faustina - The Secretary of God's Mercy

St. Maria Faustina Kowalska, the Secretary and Apostle of Divine Mercy and one of the great mystics of the Catholic Church, was born on August 25, 1905 in Giogowiec (Łódź region), Poland. She was canonized and declared Saint on April 30th, 2000 by St. Pope John Paul II, making her the first Saint of the 3rd Millenium.

Holy Trinity Catholic Church will celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday on April, 24th, 2022 at 3pm. The first-grade relic of St. Faustina will be exposed together with Jesus in the blessed Sacrament. The relic comes from St. Joseph's Convent of the Sisters of our Lady of Mercy from Cracow-Lagiewniki, Poland, where St. Faustina lived as a novice, professed her first and perpetual vows, served as cook, gardener, and doorkeeper, and spent the last years of her earthly life.

St. Faustina died on October 5th, 1938 at the age of 33. The First-Class Relic – ex ossibus – (from the bones of St. Faustina) are given by the Congregation exclusively to parishes, churches or chapels that are dedicated to "The Divine Mercy," "Merciful Jesus," or "Saint Faustina" and wherein the truth of the Merciful Love of God toward man is proclaimed. The relic is permanently placed in our Chapel at Holy Trinity for public veneration.

St. Faustina's spiritual presence at Holy Trinity will contribute to a deeper understanding of the mystery of Divine Mercy amongst us. Making St. Faustina's desire written in her "Diary" come true: "I desire to go throughout the whole world and speak to souls about the great mercy of God" (Diary 491). "This is my mission, which You Yourself have entrusted me, O Lord, in this life and in the life to come" (Diary 1325).

May the presence of St. Faustina by means of her relic fill the hearts of all our parishioners at Holy Trinity Catholic Church with joy, for the Lord Jesus said: For your sake, I grant blessings to this whole vicinity (Diary 719), for your sake I will bless the earth (Diary 431).

"I am giving you the task to write down everything that I make known to you about my mercy. For the benefit of those who by reading these things will be comforted in their souls and will have the courage to approach Me. I, therefore want you to devote all your free moments to writing." (Diary 1693) "...You are the secretary of My mercy. I have chosen you for that office in this life and the next life" (Diary 1605) "...In the old covenant I sent prophets wielding thunderbolts to my people. Today I am sending you with My mercy to the people of the whole world. I do not want to punish aching mankind but I desire to heal it pressing it to My merciful heart..." (Diary 1588) "...I demand that you devote all your free moments to writing about My goodness and mercy. It is your office and your assignment throughout your life to continue to make known to souls the great mercy I have for them and to exhort them to trust in My bottomless mercy" (Diary 1567) "My daughter; tell souls that I am giving them My mercy as a defense. I, Myself, am fighting for them and am bearing the just anger of My Father." (Diary 1516)







## St. Faustina - La secretaria de la misericordia de Dios

Santa Maria Faustina Kowalska, la secretaria y apostol de la divina misericordia y una de las mas grandes misticas de la iglesia catolica, nacio el 25 de Agosto, 1905 en Giogowiec (Łódź region), Polonia. Fue canonizada y declarada Santa el 30 de Abril, 2000 por St. Juan Pablo II, haciendola la primer santa del 3" milenio.

Nuestra parroquia de la Santisima Trinidad celebrara el **Domingo de la Divina Misericordia el 24** de **Abril**, **2022 a las 3pm**, con exposicion del Santisimo y la reliquia primer grado de Santa Faustina, que llega directamente del Convento St. Jose de las Hermanas de nuestra Señora de Misericordia en Cracow-Lagiewniki, Polonia, en donde St. Faustina vivio como novicia, profeso sus primeros y perpetuos votos, sirviendo como cocinera, jardinera, guardia, y en donde vivio sus ultimos dias de su vida terrenal.

Santa Faustina murio el 5 de Octubre, 1938 a los 33 años. La reliquia primer grado – ex ossibus – (de los huesos de St. Faustina) son dados por la Congregación exclusivamente a las parroquias, iglesias o capillas que se dedican a "La Divina Misericordia", "Jesús Misericordioso" o "Santa Faustina" y donde la verdad del amor Misericordioso de Dios hacia el hombre es especialmente proclamada, permanentemente colocado en nuestra Capilla de la Santísima Trinidad para la veneración pública.

La presencia espiritual de Santa Faustina en la iglesia de la Santísima Trinidad contribuirà a una comprensión más profunda del misterio de la Divina Misericordia entre nosotros. Hacer realidad el deseo de St. Faustina en su "Diario": "Deseo atravesar el mundo entero y hablar a las almas de la gran misericordia de Dios" (Diario 491). "Esta es mi mision que Tu mismo me has confiado en esta y en la vida futura" (Diario 1325).

Que la presencia de Santa Faustina por medio de su reliquia llene de alegría los corazones de todos nuestros feligreses de nuestra parroquia de la Santísima Trinidad, porque el Señor Jesús dijo: Por ti concedo gracias a toda la comarca (Diario 719), por ti bendigo la tierra (Diario 431).

"Tu mision es la de escribir todo lo que te hago conocer sobre Mi misericordia para el provecho de aquellos que leyendo estos escritos, encontraran en sus almas consuelo y adquiriran valor para acercarse a Mi" (Diario 1693) "...Tu eres la secretaria de Mi misericordia; te he escogido para este cargo en esta y en la vida futura." (Diario 1605) "...En el Antiguo Testamento enviaba a los profetas con truenos a Mi pueblo. Hoy te envio a ti a toda la humanidad con Mi misericordia. No quiero castigar a la humanidad doliente, sino que deseo sanarla, abrazarla a Mi Corazon misericordioso..." (Diario 1588) "...Hija Mia, exijo que todos los momentos libres los dediques a escribir de Mi bondad y misericordia; esta es tu mision y tarea en toda tu vida para que des a conocer a las almas la gran misericordia que tengo con ellas y que la invites a confiar en el abismo de Mi misericordia..." (Diario 1567) "Dile a las almas, Hija Mia, que le doy Mi misericordia como defensa, lucho por ellas Yo solo y soporto la justa ira de Mi Padre." (Diario 1516)



### Inspiration for the week

Mercy makes us attentive to the voice of truth. We do not know what ever happened to the woman caught in adultery, after her encounter with Jesus. It is hoped that she found what she needed to feel true sorrow. What we do know is that through his gentle and wise persuasiveness, Jesus puts the Pharisees in their place and opens the door to grace for this child of God. Being exploited and used to test and discredit Jesus, she who is publicly known to be a sinner is now the victim. Jesus never tolerates people being used and immediately rushes to her defense. As the author of mercy, Jesus became her advocate and opened the door for her to God's love. Jesus also stands between us and the harsh, judgmental, and often hurtful stance of our world. He invites us to grace, to leave the sin that binds us, and for which we are often criticized, and pursue a life of virtue and freedom.



### SAINT OF THE WEEK

St. Benedict the African (1524-1589), was born in San Fratello, Sicily to Cristoforo and Diana Manasseri, Africans who had been taken as slaves. Some accounts claim that because of his parents' loyal service that Benedict was given his freedom at birth, other sources say that his freedom was granted when he turned 18. At 21 Benedict joined a society of hermits living under the rule of St. Francis of Assisi. Eventually he succeeded his friend, Jerome Lanze, as their leader. When the Pope disbanded the independent hermit society, Benedict joined the Order of Friars Minor and he was sent to Palermo, to the Franciscan Friary of St. Mary of Jesus. There Benedict worked in the kitchens and despite being illiterate and a lay brother (not a priest), he also served as Master of Novices, and as Guardian of the Community. St. Benedict was known throughout his life as a brilliant cook under whose hands food seemed to multiply miraculously, a healer, and a spiritual leader with profound understanding. He is recognized as the patron saint of African Americans.




