O God, our Father, you have called us in Baptism to follow your Son Jesus through lives of loving service to you and to one another.





# Message from Fr. Rodolfo Caballero



Dear sisters and brothers in the Lord:

As we hail Jesus as our Lord and King as He enters into Jerusalem to be glorified by the Father, my invitation to you all is to accompany the Lord Jesus during those important and last hours of His earthly life with our hearts and minds focused on His offering to us. It would be good to be present at the liturgical celebrations of the week: Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday. But if one is not able to participate in all the liturgical events, that individual may do so spiritually by offering the day to the Lord, both the good things and the bad ones. And let us remember that it is not about the physical pain that is most important in the passion of Christ, but the

love with which He offered his life for each one of us. His moral suffering was way more painful that the physical one: humiliations, betrayals, denials, abandonment and loneliness are just to name a few. Ultimately, He suffered the consequences of sin like none other, yet He did not commit sin like others! Yet it is for our sake that He endured all suffering. Let us, then, thank Him for His fidelity to the Father and the giving of His life. May we be so moved upon contemplating His sacrifice that we may desire none other than corresponding to His infinite love.

May the Lord continue to bless you and each member of your family, especially the ill and the elderly.

CAM was founded in 1977 by nine downtown churches and today is supported by over 80 church communities, including Holy Trinity. As an ecumenical mission, every person who comes to CAM, regardless of beliefs, is considered a child of God. Some of the services provided are:

- Groceries every 30 days for clients with residence
- · Clothing every 30 days to include diapers and wipes
- Transportation in the form of Bus Tickets to medical appointments, to a verifiable job interview or to start a new full-time permanent job
- Limited financial assistance for utilities, voucher for I.D./Birth Certificate once every 12 months
- · Financial assistance for prescription medications up to \$80.00/year
- Yearly seasonal help for qualified clients that includes school supplies, and emergency Christmas help
- Homeless services to include showers, porta-potties, daily sack lunches, clothing and social services

All are welcome and no appointment is needed. A photo ID, Social Security Card or proof of residence for groceries is all that is necessary. For financial assistance, documentation such as disconnect notices or prescriptions are required.



# **Divorced & Separated Ministry**

#### **TURN ON THE LIGHT**

At any given time, everyone has some aspect of their life that could be described as in

"darkness." It could be physical darkness due to an illness with yourself or a loved one. It could be financial darkness due to the loss of a job. Or, it could be emotional darkness due to a divorce. Whatever your darkness is, it is sure to create a lot of fear and anxiety.

The great news is Jesus has provided a pathway out of the darkness: belief in Him. This belief is much more than a mental decision. It requires a total, complete, trust. The kind of clinging-to-the-scrap-of-wood-when-you're-adrift-in-the-middle-of-a-stormy-sea trust. That piece of wood is your lifeline. Your life depends on it, and you are not letting go of it no matter what. That is the type of trust you must have in Christ. # THE ART OF REALLY LISTENING

Have you ever reflected on how many times in the Bible we hear of God's listening? In Exodus 2:24 we read how "God heard their groaning and he remembered his covenant with Abraham, with Isaac and with Jacob." 



# The Image of Divine Mercy

The promises that our Lord makes to mankind focus primarily on three of the major elements of the Divine Mercy revelations given to St. Faustina: 1) the IMAGE, 2) the CHAPLET OF DIVINE MERCY, 3) the FEAST DAY known as DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY. Today we'll discuss the IMAGE.

On Feb. 22, 1931 Faustina writes: "In the evening, when I was in my cell, I saw the Lord Jesus clothed in a white garment One hand [was] raised in the gesture of blessing, the other was touching the garment at the breast. ...at the breast, there were emanating two large rays, one red, the other pale. Jesus said to me, Paint an Image according to the pattern you see, with the signature: Jesus, I trust in You. I desire that this Image be venerated, first in your chapel, and [then] throughout the world. (Diary #47) I promise that the soul that will venerate this Image will not perish. I also promise victory over [its] enemies already here on earth, especially at the hour of death. I Myself will defend it as My own glory. (Diary #49)

The two rays denote Blood and Water. The pale ray stands for the Water which makes souls righteous. The red ray stands for the Blood which is the life of souls... These two rays issued forth from the very depths of My tender mercy when My agonized Heart was opened by a lance on the Cross. These rays shield souls from the wrath of My Father. Happy is the one who will dwell in their shelter, for the just hand of God shall not lay hold of him. (Diary #299)

Later in the Diary Jesus continues: Not in the beauty of the color, nor of the brush lies the greatness of this image, but in My grace. (Diary #313) I am offering people a vessel with which they are to keep coming for graces to the fountain of mercy. That vessel is this image with the signature: "Jesus, I trust in You". (Diary #327) I desire that the image be publicly honored. (Diary #414) "... the image is to be on view in the church. ... By means of this image I shall be granting many graces to souls; so, let every soul have access to it." (Diary #570)

Already there are many souls who have been drawn to My love by this image. My mercy acts in souls through this work. (Diary 1379)

Though many graces flow to mankind through the image, keep in mind that we venerate it, we do not worship it. We worship what the image symbolizes — the unfathomable mercy of God as revealed to us through His incamate Son. As Jesus told St. Faustina: "My Heart rejoices in this title of Mercy. (Diary #300) Proclaim that mercy is the greatest attribute of God. All the works of My hands are crowned with mercy. (Diary #301)







# La imagen de la Divina Misericordia

Las promesas de nuestro seflor a la humanidad se enfocan en tres de los principales elementos revelados en el mensaje de la Divina Misericordia a Santa Faustina: 1) La imagen,2) La coronilla de la Divina Misericordia, 3) La flesta de la Divina Misericordia. Hoy habiaremos sobre la IMAGEN.

Santa Faustina escribio el 22 de Febrero de 1931: "Al anochecer, estando en mi ceida, vi al Señor Jesús vestido con una túnica bianca. Tenía una mano levantada para bendecir y con la otra tocaba la túnica sobre el pecho. De la abertura de la túnica en el pecho, salian dos grandes rayos: uno rojo y otro pálido. En silencio, atentamente miraba al Señor, mi alma estaba llena del temor, pero también de una gran alegría. Después de un momento, Jesús me dijo: Pinta una imagen según el modelo que vez, y firma: Jesús, en Ti conflo. Deseo que esta imagen sea venerada primero en tu capilla y luego en el mundo entero. (Diario #47) Prometo que el alma que venera esta imagen no perecerá. También prometo, ya aqui en la tierra, la victoria sobre los enemigos y sobre todo, a la hora de la muerte, Yo Mismo la defenderé como Mi gioria. (Diario#49)

Los dos rayos significan la Sangre y el Agua. El rayo pálido simboliza el Agua que justifica a las almas. El rayo rojo simboliza la Sangre que es la vida de las almas Ambos rayos brotaron de las entrañas más profundas de Mi misericordia cuando Mi Corazón agonizante fue abierto en la cruz por la lanza. Estos rayos protegen a las almas de la indignación de Mi Padre. Bienaventurado quien viva a la sombra de ellos, porque no le alcanzara la justa mano de Dios. (Diario # 299)

Jesus continua dictando a Santa Faustina en su diario: No en la belleza del color, ni en la del pincel, está la grandeza de esta imagen, sino en Mi gracia. (Diario 313)

Ofrezco a los hombres un recipiente con el que han de venir a la Fuente de la Misericordia para recoger gracias. Ese recipiente es esta imagen con la firma: Jesús, en Ti confio. (Diario # 327)

Deseo que esta imagen sea venerada en publico. (Diario # 414) ...Dile al confesor que la imagen esté expuesta en la iglesia y no en el convento dentro de la clausura. Por medio de esta imagen colmaré a las almas con muchas gracias, por eso, que cada alma tenga acceso a ella. (Diario # 570)

Ya muchas almas han sido atraidas a Mi amor por esta imagen. Mi misericordia actúa en las almas mediante esta obra. (Diario # 1379)

A pesar de que muchas gracias se derraman a la humanidad por esta imagen, ten presente que a la imagen se le venera, mas no la adoramos; adoramos lo que la imagen simboliza: La infinita misericordia de Dios que nos fue revelada atravez de la encamación de Su divino hijo Jesus. Jesus dijo a Sta Faustina: Mi Corazón se alegra de este título de misericordia. (Diario # 300) Proclama que la misericordia es el atributo más grande de Dios. Todas las obras de Mis manos están coronadas por la misericordia. (Diario # 301)



## LIVE THE LITURGY

#### Inspiration for the week

Hailed one moment and rejected the next. This seems to be the pattern that repeats itself not only throughout history but in our own lives as well. Jesus wants to be triumphantly welcomed into our hearts with joy! And welcome him we do! Then come the times when we do exactly the opposite and we reject the teachings of the Gospel and turn our backs on God's friendship. The one who at one time is a friend now becomes an enemy. Jesus understands our ambivalence. He lived it on the way to the cross. Understanding the full array of human emotion, God accepts us where we are. There is a great deal of drama on the road to Calvary. Our lives can be dramatic as well. In all of those whirlwind moments it can be difficult to find God's presence and understand his will. We walk with Jesus this week seeking inspiration and hope, the essential keys needed to unlock the door to God's presence in our lives.



#### SAINT OF THE WEEK

At the age of 14 St. Bernadette (1844-1879) was living in abject poverty with her family in a one-room basement which had previously been used as a jail, in the town of Lourdes in southern France. She was a sickly child, having fallen victim to Cholera in 1854 and would battle asthma and tuberculosis for the rest of her short life. Bernadette was illiterate and is characterized in many accounts as slow or ignorant. It was in her 14th year that Bernadette was granted 18 visions of a 'Lady' at a grotto in Massabielle. The Lady instructed Bernadette to come daily to the grotto to receive the visions, eventually proclaiming 1 am the Immaculate Conception'. A spring at the grotto, which appeared where Bernadette was instructed to dig, has been a site of miraculous healing. The Lady also asked that a chapel be built in the grotto for pilgrims. Today the Marian shrine at Lourdes is one of the world's most popular.

During and following the period of visions, the saint was examined rigorously by Church and local authorities. The popular excitement around the visions left her subject to persistent questioning and attention. Eventually she sought protection by retiring to a home for the poor in a nunnery. She took her vows in 1866 with the Sisters of Charity at Nevers. She worked as an infirmary assistant, and later a sacristan, but by the end of her life she was too sick to participate in convent life. She died at the age of 35, humble and penitent until the end.


