

O God, our Father, you have called us in Baptism to follow your Son Jesus through lives of loving service to you and to one another.





CAM's Mission:

Sharing the love of Christ by providing immediate assistance and encouragement to people in crisis

CAM was founded in 1977 by nine downtown churches and today is supported by over 80 church communities, including Holy Trinity. As an ecumenical mission, every person who comes to CAM, regardless of beliefs, is considered a child of God. Some of the services provided are:

- Groceries every 30 days for clients with residence
- · Clothing every 30 days to include diapers and wipes
- Transportation in the form of Bus Tickets to medical appointments, to a verifiable job interview or to start a new full-time permanent job
- Limited financial assistance for utilities, voucher for I.D./Birth Certificate once every 12 months
- Financial assistance for prescription medications up to \$80.00/year
- Yearly seasonal help for qualified clients that includes school supplies, and emergency Christmas help
- Homeless services to include showers, porta-potties, daily sack lunches, clothing and social services

To Receive Services:

All are welcome and no appointment is needed. A photo ID, Social Security Card or proof of residence for groceries is all that is necessary. For financial assistance, documentation such as disconnect notices or prescriptions are required.

SPLASH! The cold water now drenching my running shoes yanked me back into reality. I was outside with my four-year-old son watching him play with water balloons. He was getting a big kick out of filling them up and throwing them at the brick wall of the house and the bed of my pick-up. Him turning his aim on me came as quite a surprise.

Why was it such a shock? After all, I was standing within five feet of him. The Chaplet of Divine Mercy and it's promises

God will refuse nothing when you entreat Him with the voice of His Son. Your sacrifice is nothing in itself, but when you join it to the sacrifice of Jesus Christ, it becomes all-powerful and has the power to appease divine wrath. God loves us in His Son. The painful passion of the Son of God constantly turns aside the wrath of God.

Our Lord's first instruction to Faustina regarding the Chaplet. Encourage souls to say the chaplet which I have given you (Diary 1541) . . . Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death (Diary 687) . . . When they say this chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person, not as the just judge, but as the merciful Savior (Diary 1541) . . . Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation. Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from My infinite mercy (Diary 687) . . . Through the chaplet, you will obtain everything, if what you ask for is compatible with My will (Diary 1731).

The souls that say this chaplet will be embraced by My mercy during their lifetime and especially at the hour of their death." (Diary 754)

The three o'clock hour is the hour of great mercy. This is the hour Our Lord died on the cross. The Lord invites us to pray the chaplet at (3:00) every afternoon, remembering Christ's death on the cross.

While St. Faustina was saying the chaplet, she heard a voice which said, Oh, what great graces I will grant to souls who say this chaplet; the very depths of My tender mercy are stirred for the sake of those who say the chaplet. Write down these words, My daughter. Speak to the world about My mercy; let all mankind recognize My unfathomable mercy. It is a sign for the end times; after it will come the day of justice. While there is still time, let them have recourse to the fount of My mercy; let them profit from the Blood and Water which gushed forth for them. (Diary 848)

Jesus said, "My daughter, encourage souls to say the chaplet which I have given to you. It pleases Me to grant everything they ask of Me by saying the chaplet. When hardened sinners say it, I will fill their souls with peace, and the hour of their death will be a happy one.

Write this for the benefit of distressed souls: when a soul sees and realizes the gravity of its sins, when the whole abyss of the misery into which it immersed itself is displayed before its eyes, let it not despair, but with trust let it throw itself into the arms of My mercy, as a child into the arms of its beloved mother. These souls have a right of priority to My compassionate Heart, they have first access to My mercy. Tell them that no soul that has called upon My mercy has been disappointed or brought to shame. I delight particularly in a soul which has placed its trust in My goodness . . ." (Diary 1541)







La Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia y sus promesas

La primera instrucción de nuestro Señor a Faustina con respecto a la Coronilla. Anima a las almas a rezar la coronilla que te he dado (Diario 1541) . . . Quienquiera que la rece recibirá gran Misericordia a la hora de la muerte (Diario 687) . . . Cuando recen esta coronilla junto a los moribundos, Me pondré entre el Padre y el alma agonizante no como el Juez Justo sino como Salvador Misericordioso (Diario 1541) . . . Los Sacerdotes se la recomendaran a los pecadores como la Ultima tabla de salvación. Quienquiera que la rece recibirá gran Misericordia a la hora de la muerte. Hasta el pecador más empedemido, si reza esta coronilla una sola vez, recibirá la gracia de Mi Misericordia Infinita. (Diario 687) . . . A traves de ella obtendras todo, si lo que pides esta de acuerdo con Mi voluntad (Diario 1731).

A las almas que recen esta coronilla, Mi misericordia las envolverá en vida y especialmente a la hora de la muerte (Diario 754)

La hora de las tres es la hora de la gran misericordia. Esta es la hora en que Nuestro Señor murió en la cruz. El Señor nos invita a rezar la coronilla a las 3:00 de la tarde, recordando la muerte de Cristo en la cruz.

Mientras Santa Faustina rezaba la coronilla, de repente, oyo una voz. Oh, qué gracias más grandes concederé a las aimas que recen esta Coronilla; Las entrañas de mi Misericordia se enternecen por quienes rezan esta Coronilla. Anota estas palabras, hija Mia, había al mundo de Mi misericordia para que toda la humanidad conozca la infinita misericordia Mia. Es una señal de los últimos tiempos, después de ella vendrá el dia de la justicia. Todavia queda tiempo, que recurran, pues, a la Fuente de Mi Misericordia, se beneficien de la Sangre y del Agua que brotó para ellos (Diario 848)

Jesus dijo, Hija mía, anima a las almas a rezar la coronilla que te he dado. A quienes recenesta coronilla, Me complazco en daries lo que Me pidan. Cuando la recen los pecadores empedernidos, colmaré sus almas de paz y la hora de su muerte será feliz.

Escribelo para las almas afligidas: Cuando un alma vea y conozca la gravedad de sus pecados, cuando a los ojos de su alma se descubra todo el abismo de la miseria en la que ha caldo, no se desespere, sino que se arroje con conflanza en brazos de Mi misericordia, como un niño en brazos de su madre amadisima. Estas almas tienen prioridad en Mi Corazón compasivo, ellas tienen preferencia en Mi misericordia. Proclama que ningún alma que ha invocado Mi misericordia ha quedado decepcionada ni ha sentido confusión. Me complazco particularmente en el alma que confla en Mi bondad. . ." (Diario 1541)



The huge stone, separating death and life, has been moved, allowing God's radiant power to usher in eternal life. When we see the truth of Christ's resurrection through eyes of love, we see the fullness of timeless beauty, truth, and wonder revealed. The emptiness of the tomb is filled with the eternity of love. We have many stones and boulders blocking the path to freedom, love, and joy. They are often too big for us to move, and they cripple us. We can take a leap of faith today and believe with all our heart, mind, and soul that there is much more than can be seen by the naked eye. There is something very holy, sacred, and eternal stirring within us. We want to live forever! Christ's resurrection brings us joy and allows us to see ourselves as we are meant to be seen, as God's children destined for glory!



SAINT OF THE WEEK

St. Anselm of Canterbury left his home in Italy to travel as a young man and ended up at the monastery in Bec, France, which was known for the teachings of its leader, Lanfranc. Anselm rose quickly to become abbot of the community and his writings are now compared in importance to those of St. Augustine.

In 1093 Anselm was appointed Archbishop of Canterbury by William II Rufus, the son and successor of William the Conqueror. However, at the time there was a controversy in Europe over whether kings or the pope had the power to invest bishops. Anselm, who believed only the pope should have the right to invest an ecclesiastical authority, spent much of his time as Archbishop exiled in Rome.

St. Anselm's teaching and works of theology are his most important contribution to the Catholic faith. He is considered of the fathers of scholastic theology and his chief achievement in philosophy was the ontological argument for the existence of God. His work Cur Deus homo? taught that atonement for sins could only be achieved through Christ. He was canonized in 1494 and named a Doctor of the Church in 1720.




