





# Message from Fr. Rodolfo Caballero

Dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

As you well know, this weekend, the second Sunday of Easter is dedicated to the mystery of the Divine Mercy. Hence, it is called Divine Mercy Sunday. This liturgical celebration is based upon the devotion to the Divine Mercy, which St. Faustina Kowalska manifested as the core of the apparitions of Jesus and associated to His promises of salvation.

St. John Paul II established that this day be designated to contemplate God's mercy in the context of Easter, because "humanity will never find peace until it turns with trust to Divine Mercy. Divine Mercy! This is the Easter gift that the Church receives from the risen Christ and offers to humanity" (St. John Paul II, Sunday of Divine Mercy, April 22, 2001).

My invitation to all our Parishioners is, as we contemplate the mystery of God's endless mercy, we may experience God's love, especially in moments of difficulty when despair or despondency may be a temptation. Divine Mercy is a particular way of looking at the Easter Mystery.



In the evening, when I was in my cell, I saw the Lord Jesus clothed in a white garment. One hand was raised in the gesture of blessing, the other was touching the garment at the breast. From beneath the garment, slightly drawn aside at the breast, there were emanating two large rays, one red, the other pale. In silence I kept my gaze fixed on the Lord; my soul was struck with awe, but also with great joy. After a while, Jesus said to me: Paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the signature: Jesus, I trust in You. I desire that this image be venerated, first in your chapel, and then throughout the world. I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish. I also promise victory over its enemies already here on earth, especially at the hour of death. I Myself will defend it as My own glory. (#47-48)

### **MASTER PLAN**

I leaned back in my chair and looked with great satisfaction upon the single sheet of paper lying on my desk. It was my detailed plan for the year. Every goal was neatly and concisely described and categorized based on my personal, spiritual and work roles. It was all there. The master plan for how my life was going to unfold over the next 365 days. The Type A in me was doing a victory dance and giving myself a High-Five. Filled with confidence, I felt invincible. All I needed to do now was execute on my plan and life would be great. Right? Wrong.

I had fallen into the same trap that so many others had. I designed my life around what I wanted my master plan to be, leaving God totally out of the picture. My trying to orchestrate every detail of my life gave God no room to work. While I may execute my plan perfectly, where I end up will be a destination of my own choosing, leaving me to wonder why I am feeling so isolated and unfulfilled. Instead, I need to invite the Holy Spirit into my planning sessions and ask Him to be the architect of my life. The result will be a life's blueprint sure to create a solid foundation of purpose and fulfillment.





# The importance of Divine Mercy

The Lord makes clear in Scripture that when He returns He's not going to deal with sin, because He's done that once and for all. When He comes again, it's "to bring salvation to those who eagerly await Him" (Heb 9:28).

Through the message of Divine Mercy, our Lord is preparing us for His final coming.

He told the great prophet of Divine Mercy, St. Maria Faustina, in one of a series of revelations in the 1930s: "Mankind will not have peace until it turns with trust to My Mercy" (Diary 300).

Jesus is telling us through the messages to St. Faustina to be merciful to each other. "My daughter...I demand from you deeds of mercy, which are to arise out of love for Me. You are to show mercy to your neighbors always and everywhere. You must not shrink from this or try to excuse or absolve yourself from it.

I am giving you three ways of exercising mercy toward your neighbor: the first-by deed, the second-by word, the third-by prayer. In these three degrees is contained the fullness of mercy, and it is an unquestionable proof of love for Me. By this means a soul glorifies and pays reverence to My mercy. Yes... there must also be acts of mercy, and I demand the worship of My mercy through the solemn celebration of the Feast and through the veneration of the image.... It is to be a reminder of the demands of My mercy, because even the strongest faith is of no avail without works." (Diary 742)

The revelations of The Divine Mercy are particularly tailored to our times. It is quite evident that St. John Paul II took these revelations very seriously. In 1981 he wrote an entire encyclical dedicated to The Divine Mercy entitled *Dives in Misericordia* (Rich in Mercy), illustrating that the heart of the mission of Jesus Christ was to reveal the merciful love of the Father.

Jesus told St. Faustina "I perform works of mercy in every soul. The greater the sinner, the greater the right he has to My mercy. (Diary 723) . . . My daughter, it is time for you to take action . . . (Diary 966) . . . Pray for souls that they be not afraid to approach the tribunal of My mercy. Do not grow weary of praying for sinners. You know what a burden their souls are to My Heart. . . . dispense My mercy. (Diary 975) . . . Pray for priests, especially during this time of harvest . . . for your sake I am blessing the earth (Diary 980) Pray as much as you can for the dying . . . Be assured that the grace of eternal salvation for certain souls in their final moment depends on your prayer. (Diary 1777)

We should not forget St. Faustina's promise to us: "Poor earth, I will not forget you," she wrote. "Although I feel that I will be immediately drowned in God as in an ocean of happiness, that will not be an obstacle to my returning to earth to encourage souls and incite them to trust in God's mercy. Indeed, this immersion in God will give me the possibility to boundless action" (Dlary, 1582).

May our going ever deeper into St. Faustina's life and writings, and our counting on her promised help, bring about what our Lord so much desires from us and needs from us to be able to fulfill His divine will in us; boundless trust in Him who is the unfailing Divine Mercy in Person.







# La importancia de la Divina Misericordia

Nuestro Padre es claro en la escritura cuando nos dice que que en su segunda venida, Jesus no vendra a liberarnos del pecado, por que ya lo ha hecho. En cambio, el vendra "para salvar a los que lo esperan" (Heb 9:28).

Por medio de estos mensajes de la Divina Misericordia, nuestro Señor nos está preparando para Su ultima venida.

El le dijo a Santa Faustina en una de sus revelaciones: "La humanidad no conseguirá la pazhasta que no se dirija con confianza a Mi misericordia." (Diario 300).

Jesus nos está diciendo a través de los mensajes a Santa Faustina que sean misericordiosos unos con otros. "Hija mia...Exijo de ti obras de misericordia que deben surgir del amor hacia Mi. Debes mostrar misericordia al projimo siempre y en todas partes. No puedes dejar de hacerlo ni excusarte ni justificarte.

Te doy tres formas de ejercer misericordia al projimo: la primera – la accion, la segunda – la palabra, la tercera – la oracion. En estas tres formas está contenida la plenitud de la misericordia y es el testimonio irrefutable del amor hacia Mi. De este modo el alma alaba y adora Mi misericordia. Si... pero tambien debe estar presente la accion y pido se rinda culto a Mi misericordia con la solemne celebración de esta Fiesta y con el culto a la imagen que ha sido pintada..... ella ha de recordar a los hombres las exigencias de Mi misericordia, porque la fe sin obras, por fuerte que sea, es inútil." (Diario742)

Las revelaciones de La Divina Misericordia están especialmente adaptadas a nuestros tiempos. Es bastante evidente que San Juan Pablo II tomó estas revelaciones muy en serio. En 1981 escribió una enciclica entera dedicada a la Divina Misericordia titulada "Dives in Misericordia", ilustrando que el corazón de la misión de Jesucristo fue revelar el amor misericordioso del Padre.

Jesus le dijo a St. Faustina "En cada alma cumplo la obra de la misericordia, y cuanto mas grande es el pecador, tanto mas grande es el derecho que tiene a Mi misericordia. (Diario 723) . . . Hija Mia, debes ponerte a la obra . . (Diario 966) . . . Ruega por las almas para que no tengan miedo de acercarse al tribunal de Mi misericordia. No dejes de rogar por los pecadores. Tu sabes cuánto sus almas pesan sobre Mi corazón. . . . prodiga Mi misericordia. (Diario 975) . . . ruega por los sacerdotes, especialmente en este tiempo de cosecha . . por ti bendigo la tierra. (Diario 980) Reza, cuanto puedas, por los agonizantes. . . Has de saber que la gracia de la salvación eterna de algunas almas en el último momento dependió de tu oración. (Diario 1777)

No debemos olvidar la promesa de Santa Faustina: "¡No te olvidaré, pobre tierra!, aunque siento que me sumergiré inmediatamente toda en Dios, como en un océano de felicidad, eso no me impedirá volver a la tierra y dar ánimo a las almas e invitarlas a confiar en la Divina Misericordia. Al contrario, esa inmersión en Dios me dará unas posibilidades ilimitadas de obrar" (Diario 1582).

Profundizando en la vida de Santa Faustina y lo que escribio en su diario, podemos contar con su promesa de ayuda. Ella nos ayudara con lo que nuestro Padre desea tanto de nosotros, nuestra confianza sin limites en su divina voluntad que es la misericordia infinita, para que El pueda actuar en nosotros.



### LIVE THE LITURGY

### Inspiration for the week

Life is about to get very interesting for the disciples. Finding themselves questioning what happened to Jesus and whether he actually was raised from the dead, they are afraid and uncertain. In the midst of this fear, questioning, and uncertainty, Jesus decides to surprise them with a visit! This visit, complete with the gift of peace, fills the disciples with great excitement and joy. But their detailed testimony is not enough to convince their absent friend Thomas. He wants to see for himself. We struggle with belief as well. It is hard for some to give themselves over to the testimony of another. We want to see the resurrected Christ in person. God, through the gift of eyes of faith, gives us the ability to do precisely that: when we witness the healing that comes from forgiveness, the beauty that flows from love, the wonder of creation, the new life that comes after we fall, and the unique soul that lives behind each person's life. Christ is risen. Life will get very interesting for us too, when we stop unbelieving and believe!



### SAINT OF THE WEEK

Central America's first saint, St. Pedro de San José Betancur (1626-1667) was born a poor shepherd in the Canary Islands. His family lands were seized because of debt, and he worked as an indentured servant until his early adult life when Pedro left his home to travel to Guatemala. His money for the journey ran out long before he arrived. He was destitute when he did arrive and was forced to join the bread line the Franciscan Friars had for the poor.

In 1655, he joined the Third Order of St Francis. Pedro began to serve the poor, the enslaved, immigrants, abandoned children, anyone that needed him. In 1658 he was given a hut which he made into a hospital for the poor. This small start grew into a shelter for the homeless, a school for the poor, an inn for priests, and several small chapels in poor areas. He was supported by many patrons and was joined in his work by both men and women, who became the Bethlehemite Brothers and the Bethlehemite Sisters.

Pedro prayed for the souls of those in purgatory, walked through the streets of rich neighborhoods ringing a bell and calling the wealthy to repent, and ministered to prisoners. Most accounts credit him with beginning the tradition of posadas, a procession in which people representing Mary and Joseph ask for lodging from their neighbors. This tradition continues today in Mexico and Central America. Because of his work with the poor and marginalized Pedro is often referred to as the "Saint Frances of the Americas". St. Pedro was canonized on July 30, 2002, in Guatemala City, Guatemala by Pope John Paul II.


