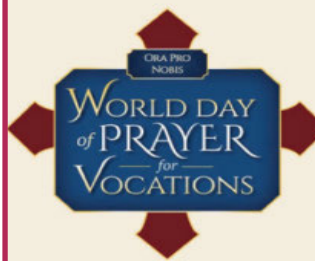

Message from Fr. Rodolfo Caballero



Dear sisters and brothers in Christ:

As we participate in the fourth Sunday of Easter, we contemplate Jesus Christ our Good Shepherd. In early Christianity, when the cross was still a form of torture and the memory of Christ crucified was still fresh in the minds of his disciples as a terrible form of torture, Christians would prefer to use this image about Jesus Christ: a young boy carrying a sheep (we might say the lost sheep of the Gospel) around his shoulders. If you notice, on the covers of many versions of the Catechism of the Catholic Church, a sitting shepherd is depicted with his staff on hand and a version of a flute. Next to him there is also a sheep with the shepherd and listening to him. May we as the sheep of the Lord listen to the voice of Jesus and follow His footsteps, knowing that in Him we will find rest and protection as we walk in dark valleys. He will refresh our souls as He leads us to refreshing waters.

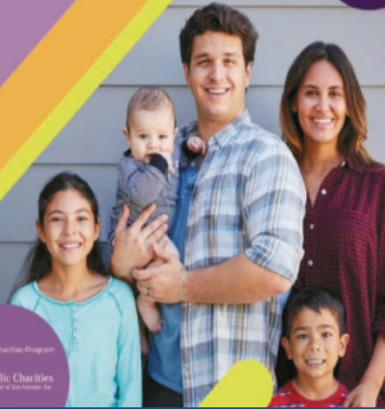

DOES ANYBODY HEAR ME?

Think about this. How many times when somebody is grieving a loss or has a problem do we actually just listen? Most of us don't. We try and solve it. But Stephen Ministry training teaches that often what is needed most is a person to just sit and listen to the hurting individual and hold that person in God's love. LIVE THE LITURGY

Inspiration for the week

Do we hear and follow? Before we can welcome Jesus as the Good Shepherd, we have to hear his voice. God's voice breaks into the dialogue of our lives in myriad ways, but we have to be attentive and receptive in order to hear it. It comes through the beauty of creation, the warmth and energy of love, the gift of compassion both received and given, the sacred miracle of life, and the orderly and purposeful design of things and in the truth found in God's commandments. Once we see the wisdom behind the commandments and teachings God places before us and are attentive to listening for His direction, we can begin to take the necessary steps and follow Him. We are easily misled and there are many convincing "shepherds." Only one is Good. It is only the Good Shepherd who can lead us away from the evils that can hurt us and bring us to the good. We may not always like where God asks us to go, and it may not be the path others prefer to take. But we have to follow it because we trust that our kind Shepherd will keep us safe.



SAINT OF THE WEEK

People may be familiar with leprosy from Biblical times, but not so much in the 1800s. However, St. Damien de Veuster of Moloka'i (January 3, 1840 – April 15, 1889) would eventually shed a light on the effects of this devastating disease and allow people to see those afflicted with it with more compassion and love.

Born Joseph de Veuster in Tremelo, Belgium, he quit school at 13 so he could work on the family farm. Feeling called for more, however, he entered the Congregation of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary six years later, where he took the name of a fourth-century physician and martyr. His brother, a priest from the same congregation, fell ill and was unable to go to his assigned location. Damien quickly volunteered in his place and found himself on the Hawaiian Islands in 1864. Two months after arriving, he was ordained a priest of Honolulu and assigned to the Island of Hawaii.

In 1873, he visited the Hawaiian government's leper colony on the island of Moloka'i, where he petitioned to stay permanently to care for their physical, medical, and spiritual needs. After years of working to improve their location and those who lived there, he contracted Hansen's disease and died of its complications. St. Damien was canonized by Pope Benedict XVI on October 11, 2009.

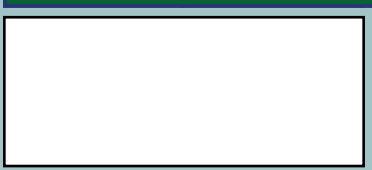

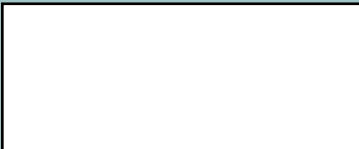
