



Message from Fr. Rodolfo Caballero



Dear sisters and brothers in Christ.

In the context of the mystery of the Lord's Resurrection, we are reminded of the only commandment that Jesus Christ left us: "I give you a new commandment: love one another as I have loved you, so you also should love one another". Not that the ten commandments were abrogated. On the contrary, the commandment of Christian love is the culmination of the commandments. In fact, the reason by which we fulfill the other commandments, or any other prescription for that end, is precisely out of love. Love is the soul of everything that we do. In Christian spirituality and love are God's grace, God's presence in us, that activates our dynamism into

reaching out to others, because they are loved by God's infinite love and are redeemed by Him. God has makes his dwelling place in them as well. The key to loving others is not in us, but is in the fact that God loves them, as much as He loves us and died for us. If anyone wonders how we can increase our love for others, the answer is this: live and experience God's love in you. Live and experience God's infinite mercy in you. Live and experience God's indwelling in you. Then you will be able to exercise that same love of God towards others.



NO MATTER WHAT

One morning I walked into Mass very distracted and anxious. I had many things on my mind: projects due at work, challenges with the kids, financial pressures, dealing with the ex, etc. On top of that, I wasn't feeling well. It was hard to focus on the Mass. Frankly, I was just going through the motions. After I received the Blessed Sacrament, I was walking back to the pew when I heard it. It was a kind of whisper in my soul that said, "No matter what is going on out there, I am always here." A feeling of peace flooded over me. Christ was reminding me that, while my life was stressful and unpredictable, His peace was available to me any time I needed it. I could unplug from the craziness of my life simply by coming to Mass. Time could almost stand still. My worries, fears and doubts could be put on hold. The Mass can be the oasis in my desert, a port in my storm. I never forgot it.

Going through a divorce brings on a tsunami of challenges, emotions, and uncertainty. And these typically don't stop after the divorce is final. There are aftershocks of some kind, often for years to come. You can unplug from all of this at any time by going to Mass. Walking in the doors of the church, receiving Christ, even just being in His presence, is giving yourself a gift. A gift of His peace. A gift you can receive everyday if you need, or wish. Christ and His peace are only as far away as your nearest Catholic church. Claim your gift in the Mass.


CHRIST CARING FOR PEOPLE THROUGH PEOPLE

Inspiration for the week

The resurrected Christ gives us the strength to do things we can never have imagined. Life will often give us mountains to climb, and we wonder how we will find the energy, ability, and determination to forge ahead. But, with a good dosage of faith and a fervent life of prayer we find ourselves succeeding and ascending to heights that once frightened us. What we realize after we have reached the other side is that this hardship we once saw as an obstacle has become a vehicle for something better and greater. We are stronger. The same is true with the Gospel. The prospect of loving one another may seem idealistic or unobtainable. Yet, when we risk moving beyond just looking out for or helping each other to actually LOVING each other, miracles happen. There is something wonderful that occurs with love. We see people in ways we never saw before, understanding and appreciating each other's journey. Love leads to reverence. Faith is strengthened and we move on to try again.



SAINT OF THE WEEK

Though St. Margaret of Cortona (1247 – 1297) is today known as being an incredibly pious Catholic, she didn't start out that way. Born into a farming family in Laviano, Tuscany, her mother died when St. Margaret was seven. Her father remarried, but life with her stepmother was so difficult that St. Margaret moved out of the home and instead chose to live with a man named Arsenio, though they weren't married. They had been living together for nine years when she gave birth to a son. Knowing in her heart that this wasn't the life that God intended for her to have, she prayed for purity.

One day while waiting for Arsenio, his dog led her into the forest where she found Arsenio murdered. So shocked was St. Margaret that she fell into a life of penance. She and her son returned to Laviano, but still found her stepmother to be as unwelcoming as ever. They then went to Cortona, and eventually her son became a friar.

Three years after her conversion, St. Margaret followed in her son's footsteps and became a Franciscan tertiary. During her life, St. Margaret established a hospital and founded a congregation of tertiary sisters. She was canonized in 1728.








Figure 1: Notice the very small blood vessels surrounding each nerve.




Figure 2: When blood vessels become diseased, they shrivel and are no longer able to provide nourishment to the surrounding nerves.
