





My daughter recently graduated from school and was embarking on a major job search. It was rather nerve-wracking for her as she marketed herself to prospective employers. She spent hours working on her resume until it was just right. She would meticulously do her hair and makeup, and make sure she was dressed perfectly. Then, she would venture out to shake hands and drop off resumes in the hope of getting an interview. Each day she put her self-worth on the line, hoping that someone would accept her, all the while bracing for rejection.

From your desired college, to your employer, to the mortgage company, to your tennis team, it seems you are always having to convince others that you are worthy, that you should be accepted. Not so with Jesus. He loved you first, and there is nothing you need to do to keep His love; nor is there anything you can ever do that will stop Him from loving you. With Jesus you don't have to prove your worth; you are already worthy. You don't have to meet certain criteria; you already do. There is no application process to go through; you are already accepted. Take great comfort in this, and let Jesus be your source of acceptance and approval instead of a world that so often tells you that you are not good enough. With Jesus, you are always pre-approved!

THE ART OF REALLY LISTENING

Have you ever reflected on how many times in the Bible we hear of God's listening? In Exodus 2:24 we read how "God heard their groaning and he remembered his covenant with Abraham, with Isaac and with Jacob." Through his prophet Isaiah God said, "Before they call I will answer; while they are still speaking I will hear." (Isaiah 65:24) And we see too how Jesus called upon His Father, thanking Him, asking Him to heal, to have mercy, to take away this cross, and then placing it all in His Father's hands.

Sometimes we wish we could do something for those around us who are hurting. But perhaps, though it may not seem like much, all we are called to do at the moment is to "be quick to listen, slow to speak" (James 1:19a). God can work through our caring listening like a soothing salve on a wound, bringing about healing, deeper self-understanding, and the abundant life that Jesus promised.

Listening is an essential part of Stephen Ministry. Stephen Ministers use active listening skills to help people recognize and accept the feelings they are experiencing. If you or someone you know is hurting, having someone to listen with compassionate understanding without judging and with prayerful attention may be just what is needed.







Frequently Asked Questions about Annulments

(a series taken from The Metropolitan Tribunal of the Archdiocese of San Antonio)

What is the difference between a Divorce and an Annulment (or a Declaration of Marriage Nullity)?

- A civil divorce is a legal action whereby the division of property and custody of children having been settled, a civil dissolution is granted, and husband and wife are declared free by the same civil authority to enter a new marriage with a different partner. Such a civil procedure does not question the validity of the initial consent in that marriage.
- By contrast, if the gathered factual evidence, examined in the light of canon (Church) law, shows that a particular marriage was not canonically valid, the Church's Tribunal declares it null and void. This is the ecclesiastical Decree of Marriage Nullity (colloquially called an "annulment"). The Church does not make the marriage null, but rather recognizes that the marriage is null.



SAINT OF THE WEEK

St. Joan of Arc (1412 – 1431) has had her story told throughout history through many books, movies and plays. She was born in the village of Domrémy, near the province of Lorraine, to a French peasant family. At a young age, she began to experience visions and voices, which were later identified to be of St. Michael, St. Catherine of Alexandria, and St. Margaret of Antioch. At the age of 13, all three saints told her that she was to drive the English from French territory, and that she must bring the Dauphin to Reims for his coronation. Trusting in God, she did as she was told.

During the Hundred Years War, St. Joan of Arc led French troops against the English and recaptured the cities of Orléans and Troyes. Captured near Compiegne the following year, she was sold to the English and placed on trial for heresy and witchcraft, eventually being found guilty and burned at the stake in Rouen.

St. Joan of Arc was canonized by Pope Benedict XV on May 16, 1920, and is the patron saint of military members.


