At our petition, Archbishop Gustavo reduced our financial obligation by \$300,000, leaving us with \$901,700 in available funds. Though not enough to pursue the original plans, these funds will allow us to make some of the many necessary upgrades to our campus. Having heard opinion of the Finance Council members, we would like to use these funds to improve our Pavilion, the playground area and to create an inviting place of fellowship where we can gather after Church to relax and enjoy. This space is in demand, as indicated in feedback from our Parishioners. Many thanks to Archbishop Gustavo for his help in this matter. Blessings to everyone.



Divorced & Separated Ministry TURN ABOUT IS FAIR PLAY

I don't think there has ever been a more public display of human suffering than the Passion of our Lord. His suffering was not limited to one particular place, witnessed by a few. His suffering was through the streets of Jerusalem with thousands witnessing the entire grueling ordeal. In the midst of that suffering, Simon of Cyrene comes to Jesus's aid. He helps relieve some of Christ's suffering by carrying His cross. Simon was a glimpse of hope in the midst of total despair.

Now Jesus offers you the same hope in the midst of your despair. He longs to return the favor of Simon by helping you carry your cross. Be aware of moments during your day when Jesus is reaching out to help you. It could be in the form of a phone call from a friend, a coworker offering to assist with a project, your mother stepping in to help with the kids, or simply a moment of peace. Jesus, Our Lord and Savior, knows you need help and is actively trying to step in. Will you let Him?

Are you feeling alone due to a recent death or divorce, experiencing the pain of loneliness within a marriage, a single person going through a difficult time with friends but no one to really listen, or someone who could use someone to talk to on a caring and confidential basis? 



(a series taken from The Metropolitan Tribunal of the Archdiocese of San Antonio)

Can a marriage lasting many years be declared invalid?

The Tribunal process examines the events leading up to, and at the time of the wedding ceremony, in an effort to determine whether what was requiredfor a valid marriage was ever brought about.

The length of common life is not proof of validity but a long marriage does provide evidence that a couple had some capacity for a life-long commitment. It does not prove or disprove the existence of a valid marriage bond.



When we allow God's Own breath to truly take possession of us, we realize that we are meant to become like God and know Him as He really is. This ultimate helper lifts our eyes from what is below to what is above and empowers us to live life with joy and keener vision!



SAINT OF THE WEEK

Born to nobility, St. Norbert of Xanten, was ordained as a subdeacon and served in the court of Henry V, Emperor of Germany, however, at court it was easy to be distracted by wealth, power and luxury and he lived a worldly and corrupt life there. By the grace of God while traveling in a storm he was nearly struck by lightning and almost killed. This experience changed St. Norbert and he became penitent, left his court post, and after a period of discernment in a monastery, felt called to be a priest.

Norbert became an itinerant preacher, preaching against worldly attitudes but at the Pope's request finally settled in northern France and founded the Norbertine order established according to the rule of St. Augustine. The order grew rapidly and soon founded women's branch. Norbert traveled and preached across Germany where he also founded a lay branch of the Norbertines. In Belgium he preached against heresies which denied the Blessed Sacrament.

Eventually he was made Archbishop of Magdeburg, Germany, and later he traveled to Rome in support of Pope Innocent II, against the antipope. Afterward he returned to Germany to court of Emperor Lothar as advisor, at end of life, in failing health, St. Norbert was carried back to Magdeburg where he died.




