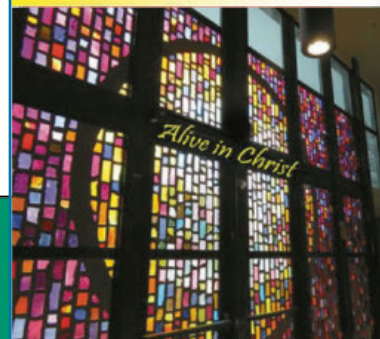

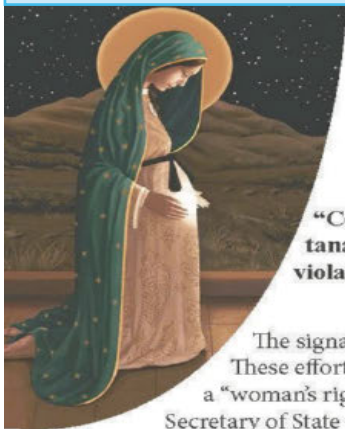

"Constitutional Initiative 128 (CI-128) would greatly expand the practice of legalized abortion in Montana abolishing the limited restrictions currently in place and opening the door to a host of practices that violate fundamental rights to life and dignity."

The signature gathering efforts to place Constitutional Initiative 128 (CI-128) on the November ballot have concluded. These efforts included substantial out-of-state funding, signing events, and vague messaging that often framed CI-128 as a "woman's right to make her own healthcare decisions." In the coming weeks, amidst likely legal challenges, the Montana Secretary of State will confirm whether the signature gathering was successful or not.

During the signature verification and count, our Catholic bishops will continue messaging the great threat that CI-128 poses to unborn children, expectant mothers, and families. Regardless of the outcome, the Church will fulfill her duty to boldly speak out and stand up for the infinite dignity of life from conception until a natural death.

Let us remain prayerfully vigilant, continuing with the Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory Be after each Mass. Let our prayer intention be for the defeat of CI-128 but even more so for a change of heart. We pray for a transformation in our hearts and the hearts of all people, especially expectant mothers and those who would promote abortion over loving each new life as a precious and unrepeatable gift.

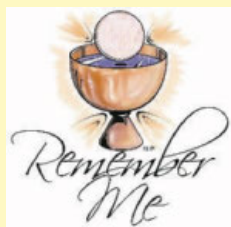

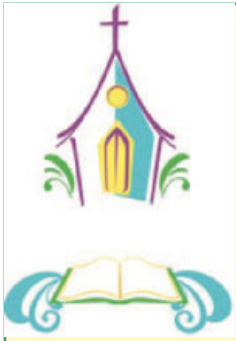

Faith over Fear

“Do not be afraid, just have faith.”

Mark 5:21-43 (verse 36b)



Adults -

1. Jairus had faith in the healing and life-giving power of Jesus. The hemorrhaging woman who had suffered for twelve years also had faith in Jesus. When have you approached Jesus in faith, trusting in his life-giving power? How did Jesus respond?
2. Jesus addressed the woman with the personal, relational, and familiar term “Daughter” and tells her that her faith saved her. He also encourages Jairus, the synagogue official, to not be afraid, but to have faith. What does it mean to you to have faith?
3. How do you participate in the healing and life-giving work of God? How can you better partner with God in transforming the world’s suffering?

Obstacles: Being impatient with yourself as you try to deepen your faith. Not recognizing that our faith matures and flows throughout our life.

Teens -

1. When Jairus came to Jesus, asking Him to save his daughter, many were telling him that his daughter had already died and that he should not bother Jesus. How was Jairus showing us to have complete faith in God over what the world is telling us?
2. Have you ever been faced with a situation that you remained strong in your faith while others lacked faith? If so, how did that make you feel?
3. Throughout your life you are going to be faced with many difficult situations and choices. How can you use Jesus’ message to Jairus of “Do not be afraid, just have faith,” to help you through these times?

Obstacles: Forgetting to lean on Jesus and have faith that he will take care of everything when difficult situations arise in your life.

Children -

1. Have you (or someone you know) ever been sick and not been able to go to school or do something you wanted to? Who took care of you (them)? Have you ever prayed to get well or prayed for someone who was sick? What happened after you prayed? Did you feel that Jesus was with you (them)?
2. How does being aware of God’s power to heal bring hope for our world? What does it mean to have faith? How does having faith bring you hope?
3. Today we heard of two people who needed Jesus to heal them. We all need healing whether it is spiritual, emotional, or physical. What type of healing do you or someone you love need right now? Take time to pray for Jesus to heal you and your loved ones where you need it most.

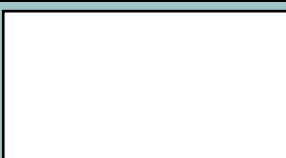
