Our celebrations tell a story, the fuller story of Christmas.

After preparing in Advent for the birth of Christ, we have adored him in the manger. Like the shepherds, the Magi, Joseph and Mary, we too have pondered this beautiful thing—the birth of Jesus—in our hearts. In the feast of the Holy Family we marked the small wonderful beginnings of our redemption, that it all began within the arms of a mother and the care of a father, amazed that God would inaugurate so vast a salvation within a family so small. At the Epiphany, we learned that though small, this child nonetheless bears cosmic significance, that although an infant, he's also king and God of everything and all.

Which brings us to the celebration of Jesus's baptism. Here we see at least two things revealed. First, in his baptism Jesus is revealed Son of the Father, that upon him the Spirit has come down. That is, he is revealed to be of the Trinity, or as we say in the Creed, "God from God and Light from Light." Such is how we interpret the dove and the voice of the Father, giving new meaning to the royal psalm, "This is my beloved Son." This feast celebrates the divine confirmation of what the Magi suspected, that this is a king indeed but more. That he is God as well, adored by all creation.

But Jesus's baptism also reveals how God has drawn near. John's baptism was preparatory; the baptism Christ inaugurates is sacramental. That is, in baptism Christ unites himself to us. In the Collect for the feast we pray that, having been adopted in baptism, we may remain faithful to Jesus so that we too may be "well pleasing." The point is that in baptism we find Jesus, God and man, and this is how we truly accept what happened at Christmas: in living the Christian life in the sacraments and in following and obeying Jesus no matter how hard the road to Calvary may prove.

So, don't forget to cross yourself in and out of Church, and by that little gesture, remember and renew your own baptism. And know that's how we can see him, how we can truly come to know Jesus, and how we can begin to be faithful in a world in need of faithful people. By meeting him in the sacraments and listening for his voice.

Nuestras celebraciones nos cuentan una historia, la historia más completa de la Navidad.

Después de prepararnos en Adviento para el nacimiento de Cristo, lo adoramos en el pesebre. Como los pastores, los magos, José y María, y nosotros también hemos reflexionado en nuestros corazones sobre esta hermosa cosa, el nacimiento de Jesús. En la fiesta de la Sagrada Familia marcamos los pequeños y maravillosos comienzos de nuestra redención, que todo comenzó en los brazos de una madre y el cuidado de un padre, maravillados de que Dios inaugurara una salvación tan vasta dentro de una familia tan pequeña. En la Epifanía, aprendimos que, a pesar de ser pequeño, este niño tiene un significado cósmico, que aunque es un bebé, también es rey y Dios de todo y de todos.

Lo cual nos lleva a la celebración del bautismo de Jesús. Aquí vemos al menos dos cosas reveladas. Primero, en su bautismo Jesús se revela Hijo del Padre, que sobre él ha descendido el Espíritu. Es decir, se revela que es de la Trinidad, o como decimos en el Credo, "Dios de Dios y Luz de Luz". Es así como interpretamos la paloma y la voz del Padre, dando un nuevo significado al salmo real: "Este es mi Hijo amado". Esta fiesta celebra la confirmación divina de lo que los magos sospechaban, que este es un verdadero rey, pero más. Que también es Dios, adorado por toda la creación.

Pero el bautismo de Jesús también revela como Dios se ha acercado. El bautismo de Juan fue de preparación; el bautismo que Cristo inaugura es sacramental. Es decir, en el bautismo Cristo se une a nosotros. En la oración Colecta de la fiesta oramos para que, habiendo sido adoptados en el bautismo, seamos fieles a Jesús para que también nosotros seamos "complacidos". El punto es que en el bautismo encontramos a Jesús, Dios y hombre, y es así como realmente aceptamos lo que sucedió en Navidad: en vivir la vida cristiana en los sacramentos y en seguir y obedecer a Jesús sin importar lo difícil que pueda resultar el camino al Calvario.

Así es que, no olvide persignarse dentro y fuera de la Iglesia, y con ese pequeño gesto, recuerde y renueve su propio bautismo. Y conozca que es así como podemos verlo, como podemos llegar a conocer verdaderamente a Jesús y cómo podemos comenzar a ser fieles en un mundo que necesita gente fiel. Encontrándolo en los sacramentos y escuchar su voz.
