 -1 Corinthians 12:13

It's what makes the Gospel so dangerous, what makes Christianity so culturally and politically destructive and we Christians so potentially subversive. Our baptism in Christ. It's a truth most Christians don't realize.

Baptism binds us to Christ who is Lord, and it also binds us together. It makes us brothers and sisters, no matter our race, our nationality, our ethnicity, our anything. Whether Jew or Greek or Mexican or American, it doesn't matter; it's transcended by our common union in Christ. The revolutionary logic is simple: if we're baptized in Christ and if that makes us sisters and brothers, each of us obedient to the same Lord, then Christ's teaching, his love and ethic, should be what binds us and orders us, Christian charity transcending and infusing all our ethics and politics. It's a truth which should reorder our loyalties. That is, before we're a political people or an ethnic people or anything like that, we're an ecclesia—a society of faith and charity, a sacramental people. This is what Paul is getting at with his image of the body of Christ, and it's what Jesus meant when he talked about the kingdom.

And it is what we ought to remember and realize. That our lives are better lived according to the charity taught and infused by Christ and less by the logics and laws of our earthly tribes. As I said, this is a truth most Christians don't realize, preferring as we do our individualist versions of Christianity which we clearly subordinate to the other powers of the world. But this is the truth, that our baptism in Christ makes our loyalty to Christ our most determinative. Which is what we must realize again if we're to be relevant again, and if to act and speak together as Christ in the world. As we're called to do.

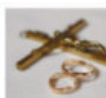
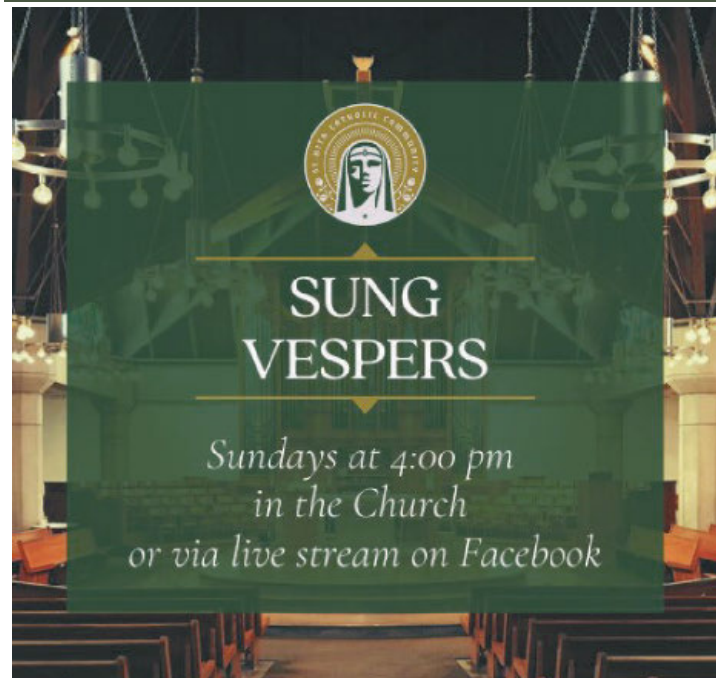

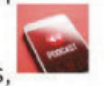

Esto es lo que hace que el Evangelio sea tan peligroso, lo que hace que el cristianismo sea cultural y políticamente destructivo y nosotros los cristianos tan potencialmente subversivos. Nuestro bautismo en Cristo. Es una verdad que la mayoría de los cristianos no se dan cuenta.

El bautismo nos une a Cristo quien es el Señor, y también nos une a nosotros. Nos hace hermanos y hermanas, sin importar nuestra raza, nuestra nacionalidad, nuestra etnia o cualquier otra cosa. Ya sea judío, griego, mexicano o americano, no importa; es manifestado por nuestra unión común en Cristo. La lógica revolucionaria es simple: si somos bautizados en Cristo y si eso nos hace hermanos y hermanas, cada uno de nosotros obedientes al mismo Señor, entonces la enseñanza de Cristo, su amor y su ética, debe ser lo que nos une y nos ordena, la caridad cristiana trascendiendo e infundiendo toda nuestra ética y política. Es una verdad que debe reordenar nuestras lealtades. Es decir, antes de ser un pueblo político o un pueblo étnico o algo parecido, somos una Iglesia, una sociedad de fe y caridad, un pueblo consagrado. Esto es a lo que Pablo se refiere con su imagen del cuerpo de Cristo, y es lo que Jesús quiso decir cuando habló del reino.

Y es lo que debemos recordar y cumplir. Que nuestras vidas sean mejor vividas según la caridad enseñada e infundida por Cristo y menos según las lógicas y leyes de nuestras tribus terrenales. Como ya dije, esta es una verdad que la mayoría de los cristianos no se dan cuenta, prefiriendo como lo hacemos con nuestras versiones individualistas del cristianismo que claramente subordinamos a los otros poderes del mundo. Pero esta es la verdad, que nuestro bautismo en Cristo hace que nuestra lealtad a Cristo sea más determinante. Que es lo que debemos darnos entender nuevamente si queremos ser relevantes otra vez, y si actuar y hablar juntos como Cristo en el mundo. Como estamos llamados a hacer.
