

St. Francis de Sales

Born of aristocrats, Francis overcame his father's resistance to take orders. He served as a bishop in exile at Annecy during the height of the Reformation. A much-sought-out spiritual director his tender yet wise I etters to a young woman, Madame de Chamoisy, formed the basis of his Intro-

duction to the Devout Life, which proposes God's merciful love as the goal and motive of every human life. "Man is the perfection of the universe; the spirit is the perfection of man; love, that of the spirit; and charity, that of love." Francis was declared a Doctor of the Church in 1877. St. Francis de Sales is the patron saint of our priests.


