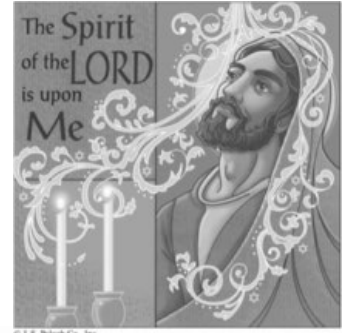

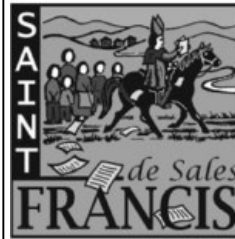

St. Francis de Sales

Born of aristocrats, Francis overcame his father's resistance to take orders. He served as a bishop in exile at Annecy during the height of the Reformation. A much-sought-out spiritual director his tender yet wise letters to a young woman, Madame de Chamoisy, formed the basis of his Introduction to the Devout Life, which proposes God's merciful love as the goal and motive of every human life. "Man is the perfection of the universe; the spirit is the perfection of man; love, that of the spirit; and charity, that of love." Francis was declared a Doctor of the Church in 1877. St. Francis de Sales is the patron saint of our priests.
