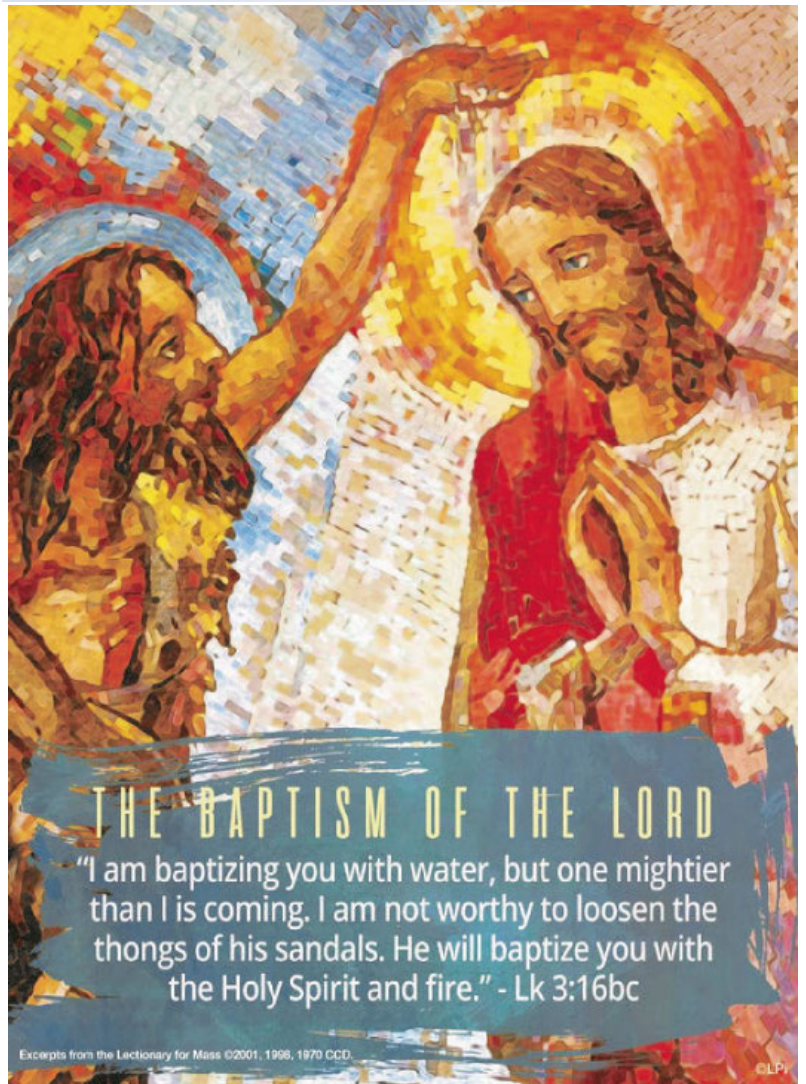

Today we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord. The Gospel story we hear from St. Luke is a bit different than what we hear in the other Gospel stories. After Jesus was baptized, Luke says that Jesus was praying and then the Holy Spirit descended upon him in the form of a dove and a voice from heaven said "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased." Luke emphasizes that Jesus was praying. What was he praying about? How often do we pray? Do we pray only when we need something? Or do we pray always? As we begin this New Year, maybe one of our resolutions could be that we will spend more time in prayer, praying daily.

We end the Christmas season today and then we move into the season of ordinary time starting on Monday, January 10th. How are we doing on our New Year's resolutions? Did we make any? How many have we broken? It is not too late to make resolutions or remake some if we have broken them. Let us resolve to be a more loving and prayerful person.

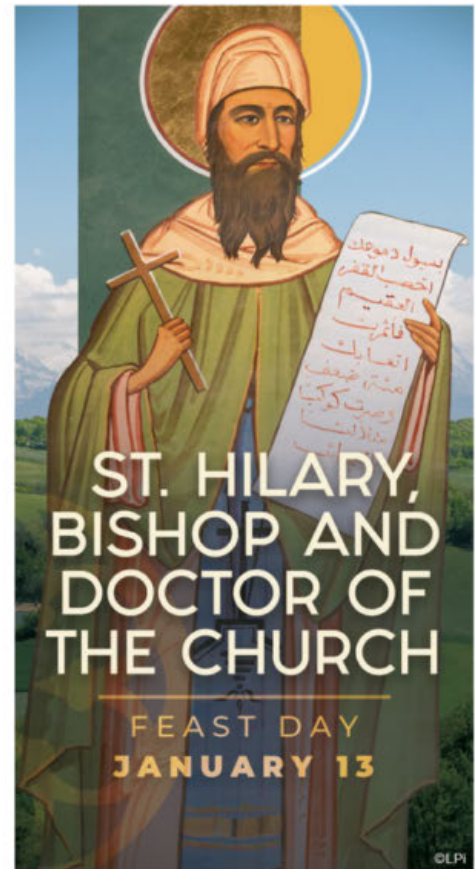

Inspiration for the week

Jesus stood in line with everyone else and was baptized. There is something incredibly humbling about how this must have played out. Then, God did something truly awesome and inspiring. Through a very gentle and simple action he let the world know about the special relationship He shares with Jesus. That's exactly what is so incredible about our baptisms as well! Through those holy waters God announces to the world the special place we also occupy in His heart. We no longer have to wonder about the purpose of our lives or struggle to find our way. We do not need to fumble around, tripping over ourselves and wondering why we are even here. The answer has been given. All we have to do is live out the vocation we have received, to live the Gospel in fidelity to our Creator. There is nothing to fear and worry has no place. Standing in line with other sinners, we have our anchor and God is very pleased.



SAINT OF THE WEEK

Born a pagan, St. Hilary (c. 315 – c. 367) studied philosophy and the meaning of life, eventually making his way through the bible. He became a convert and was appointed bishop of Poitiers in 353. Sometimes referred to as the Hammer of the Arians, St. Hilary defended the Nicene Creed against a popular heresy, Arianism. He was exiled to Phrygia for opposing Roman emperor Constantius II, who preferred the heresy which denies Christ's divinity. From Phrygia St. Hilary fought with his pen, zealously writing against the heresy.

Eventually he was allowed to return to Poitiers, but did so by a circuitous route, preaching against Arianism all the way. St. Hilary was likely the first writer of hymns in the West, his writings on the Trinity, Psalms and Gospel of Matthew survive today. St. Hilary was created Doctor of the Church, a title given to those who provided important contributions to theology and doctrine, in 1851 by Pope Pius IX.

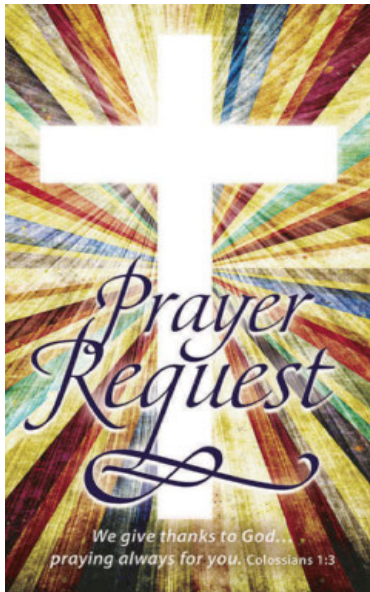

Why Register to the Parish?



Why is it so important that we register in a parish?
 Isn't it good enough that we go to Mass?

Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. Often people attend Mass at a parish for months or sometimes years, but never officially register. Registering at Holy Family is the expression of your commitment to being part of our parish community. Being a registered parishioner also makes the process much simpler when it is time for receiving sacraments, registering for faith formation (religious education), sponsoring a sacrament recipient and even planning funerals. We are often asked to provide affidavits for baptism and confirmation sponsors. We can only do this if a person is a registered, active, and contributing member in our parish. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish. So, are you a registered parishioner? If not, please register.

Registration forms are available in the vestibule of the Church.

(Young adults 18 and over, living in their parent's household should be registered separately. This is especially IMPORTANT for marriage and baptism preparation.)

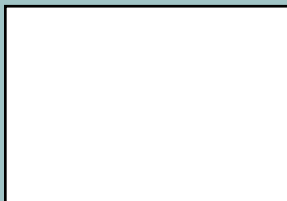

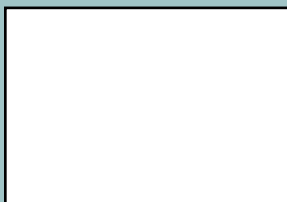
