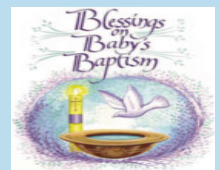

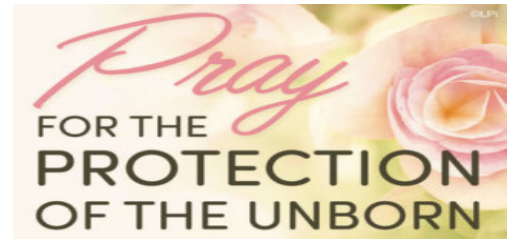

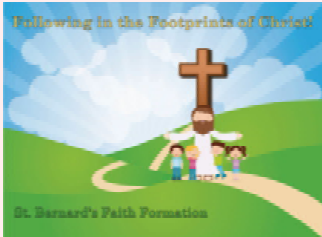

It may be wise to look at wearing masks again if they have been discarded due to the increase in the Virus. Some info re: kinds. Best: N95, KN95, KF94, nothing worn over these. Better: surgical or blue masks because of the blue-tint, more effective by placing cloth mask over them to secure with no leaks

so virus can't get in or out, and air is filtered. Good: 2layers of tightly woven cotton with 3rd layer of non-woven fabric which could be a filter insert. Less effective: 2 layer cotton masks, bandanas or gaiters. However, any cloth is better than no mask. PRAY that God has us use the best available protection.
