# Father's Notebook



# Cuaderno del Padre

## Greetings brothers and sisters in Christ,

Last week I had a full week starting with Labor Day, where I was able to preside over my youngest brother Peter's wedding in Houston. It was a beautiful event and good to have time with family. Then this week we had two Funerals Masses during the week. And last Sunday we had Baptisms within both the 8am and 10am Masses. Then in the afternoon we began our Confirmation 2 sessions with the youth preparing and learning how to serve in the 6:30pm Mass. Each of them have a specific role in the Mass and will be assisting at the 6:30pm Mass in some form or fashion. It was a joy to see them learning about the Mass and how to have a part in our worship of God. It was truly a full week, but it's this kind of week that I thank God for the vocation to be a priest and to give myself away in this way.

Just like I'm sure there is a joy of being a Father or a Mother in a family, even through tough times, there is a real joy in being a priest and spiritual Father. I hope that all of our youth will be open and encouraged to listen and respond to God's call to the priesthood or religious life if He is indeed calling them.

Often a good gauge of the health of a parish community is the amount of vocations to the priesthood and religious life that come from it. Recently, we've had Matthew Jewell and John Paul Phillips who grew up in this parish enter into seminary and discern priesthood. Let's continue to pray for them. It is not all about the number of vocations, but God is usually calling many to this beautiful way of life yet many do not hear the call or respond. Vocation comes from the Latin word "vocare" which means "to call". God is calling the youth to the priesthood, religious life and even married life.

But in order to "hear" the call one must be listening and that means listening in prayer and meditation. If the youth are able to develop an openness and listening to the will of God in their daily prayers, they will hear the loving call of Jesus. That's why spending an hour in Eucharistic Adoration with the youth is so important. There they're placed before our Lord Jesus Christ, and they are given an opportunity to be quiet and listen. To put away the distractions and phones, and to let the Lord speak. It is no wonder so many vocations come from those youth and teens who spend time frequently in Eucharistic Adoration. I pray that our parish may have an abundant vocations to the priesthood and religious life!

La semana pasada tuve una semana ocupada comenzando con el Día del Trabajo, donde pude presidir la boda de mi hermano menor Peter en Houston. Fue un evento hermoso y bueno para pasar tiempo con la familia. Luego, esta semana tuvimos dos Misas Funerarias durante la semana. Y el Domingo pasado tuvimos Bautismos en las misas de las 8 am y las 10 am. Luego, por la tarde, comenzamos nuestras sesiones de Confirmación 2 con los jóvenes preparándose y aprendiendo cómo servir en la Misa de las 6:30 pm. Cada uno de ellos tiene un papel específico en la Misa y ayudando en la Misa de las 6:30 pm de alguna forma o modo. Fue un placer verlos aprender sobre la Misa y cómo participar en nuestra adoración a Dios. Realmente fue una semana completa, pero es este tipo de semana en la que agradezco a Dios por la vocación de ser sacerdote y por entregarme de esta manera.

Al igual que estoy seguro de que hay una alegría de ser padre o madre en una familia, incluso en tiempos difíciles, hay una alegría real en ser sacerdote y Padre espiritual. Espero que todos nuestros jóvenes estén abiertos y animados a escuchar y responder al llamado de Dios al sacerdocio o la vida religiosa si Él realmente los está llamando.

A menudo, un buen indicador de la salud de una comunidad parroquial es la cantidad de vocaciones al sacerdocio y la vida religiosa que se derivan de ella. Recientemente, tuvimos a Matthew Jewell y John Paul Phillips, quienes crecieron en esta parroquia, ingresaron al seminario y disciernen el sacerdocio. Sigamos orando por ellos.

No se trata solo del número de vocaciones, pero Dios suele llamar a muchos a esta hermosa forma de vida, pero muchos no escuchan el llamado ni responden. La vocación proviene de la palabra latina "vocare" que significa "llamar". Dios está llamando a los jóvenes al sacerdocio, a la vida religiosa e incluso a la vida matrimonial.

Pero para "escuchar" la llamada hay que estar escuchando y eso significa escuchar en oración y meditación. Si los jóvenes pueden desarrollar una apertura y escuchar la voluntad de Dios en sus oraciones diarias, escucharán el llamado amoroso de Jesús. Por eso es tan importante pasar una hora en Adoración Eucarística con los jóvenes. Allí se les coloca ante nuestro Señor Jesucristo, y se les da la oportunidad de estar en silencio y escuchar. Para dejar las distracciones y los teléfonos, y dejar que el Señor hable. No es de extrañar que tantas vocaciones provengan de aquellos jóvenes y adolescentes que pasan tiempo con frecuencia en la Adoración Eucarística.

¡Oro para que nuestra parroquia tenga abundantes vocaciones al sacerdocio y a la vida religiosa!




